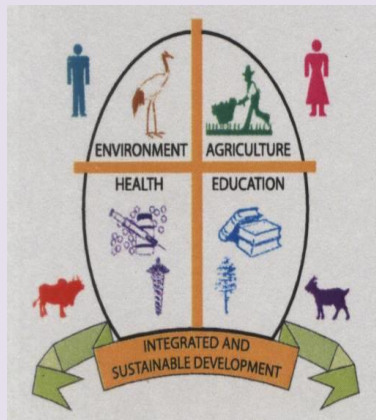

1.0 INTRODUCTION:

Ndungu Parish is among the 28 parishes of the Catholic Diocese of Same. The Parish has a total of 215 parishioners. The main economic activities are:

- Agriculture
- Livestock keeping and
- Petty businesses

The Parish is located in an agricultural an agricultural rural community involved in paddy farming. Paddy is a seasonal crop that does not earn the farmers good income as during harvesting all the villagers have to sell part of their harvest making the price very low. There is mobility of people coming from the town to purchase agricultural produce of which they spend nights in the village. This phenomenon combined with poverty, Ndungu community has become an HIV/AIDS High transmission area.

PROBLEM STATEMENT:

2.0 DESCRIPTION OF THE PROJECT: PROJECT JUSTIFICATION:

The Youth is the main working population and are the people who shape the coming generations therefore once their income improves, they will be able to create better future for the coming generation. They will be able to take their children to school, their faith will be revived and attendance in the Church will increase. Those who are engaged in illegal activities such as illegal hunting in National reserves, illegal harvesting of trees in reserved mountains and water catchment areas will not continue.

Ndungu Parish aims at starting a Piggery project to benefit the Youth and eventually the whole community especially those whose faith is not against keeping and eating pigs. Ndungu Parish will be the facilitator and base of the project but as the youth take up the initiative, they will eventually own their own projects at family levels. The Parish being the base of the project, it will raise and distribute piglets which will be used as "seeds" by the Youth individually or as groups in the community at Ndungu.

Having this project which will supply piglets to the Youth, the project will require each youth given a female pig to return two piglets after the first breeding, this will ensure sustainability of the project and that each member of the group starts his own project for his income and that of the family he / she comes from.

The Parish gets its income from the community it serves .Parishes that serve rich or better off communities has higher income compared to these that serve the poor. Therefore by enabling the community to get high income, we expect that the Parish financial position (income) will increase.

3.0 GOAL OF THE PROJECT:

Strengthened household income among youth by 2016.

4.0 OBJECTIVES OF THE PROJECT:

1. By 2016 Youth will have been given pigs
2. capacity building to Youth on livestock production specifically pig production.

The youth at Ndungu Parish to have received basic training on care and raising of Pigs by 2015.

3. The youth at Ndungu Parish to have received basic training on entrepreneurship by 2015

5.0 STRATEGY:

To establishing a pig farming project at the Parish level and once completed the Parish shall distribute the piglets to the community on condition that the recipient (Youth) shall return two piglets after the first breeding that will supply piglet to families at Ndungu Parish by June, 2014.

The project will make sure it establishes links between the Youth themselves and the market in neighbouring towns and potential buyers and users of pigs and pork.

The Project shall also link the pig keepers with Veterinary Officers in Ndungu who will train and support the youth in taking care of pigs.

6.0 IMPACT OF THE PROJECT/EXPECTED OUTCOME

6.1 Short term outcome:

- Formation of Youth groups
- Knowledge gain on entrepreneurship and business skills

6.2 Long term outcome:

- Improved nutrition of the people in the community.
- Reduction of poverty.
- Overall improvement of quality of life and that of the community

It will also look at the implementation processes and the outputs of activities whether are in line with the inputs to the project. Challenges that will be encountered in the project during implementation will be learnt corrected and used to improve implementation. The Parish priest will be responsible in giving the report concerning the development of the project to all the levels that matter to this project.
