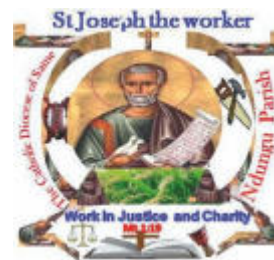
St. Joseph the Worker Sister Parish Dispatch

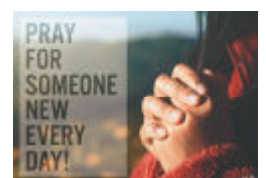

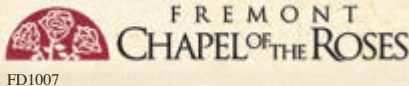
