

FROM THE DESK OF DCN. RIGO...

Jesus speaks of peace, forgiveness, and authority in today's Gospel.

Peter calls us to holiness and the Book of Acts tells us that it is through the Body and Blood that we may become saints. In line with these calls to be peaceful, forgiving, to come to the Sacrament of Reconciliation, to trust in Christ, the Church celebrates Divine Mercy Sunday. This feast day was instituted by Pope St John Paul II on April 30, 2000, when he canonized Saint Faustina Kowalski as the first saint of the new millennium.

It is fitting on this day and in these circumstances that we pray Saint Faustina's Healing Prayer:

Jesus, may Your pure and healthy blood circulate in my ailing organism, and may Your pure and healthy body transform my weak unhealthy body, and may a healthy and vigorous life flowing within me, if it is truly Your Holy will. Amen. We are also called to pray the Divine Mercy Chaplet as she wrote in her Diary: "The Lord told me to recite this chaplet for the nine days before the Feast of Mercy. It is to begin on Good Friday. By this novena (of Chaplets), I will grant every possible grace to souls."

I beg you, Holy Spirit faithful, to pray with your Pastoral Team – Fathers Ken, Lee, and John, and along with the deacons – this Chaplet right at 3:00 pm every day. Let us pray Saint Faustina's Healing Prayer so the Lord Jesus, the Divine Mercy Himself, may console and heal us.
