

FROM THE DESK OF DCN. RIGO...

There is pattern to the relationship between the Lord God and the People of God, His People, us, human beings...

He is faithful, always does what He says He will do.

We tend to be a little silly, we act whimsically.

We are not persistent, we change depending on how well we are doing, we pay attention when we need a favor, then walk away when we "do not need Him."

Let us read attentively and let these readings sink in our minds and hearts: the people of Nineveh believed, called a fast, changed their behavior; thus, they were spared. Jesus called Peter, Andrew, James, and John. You are reading correctly. Jesus calls.

They dropped their nets, left their ways to follow Him.

Take these readings to heart. They are so important that St. John Paul II included the Mark verses in the Luminous Mysteries of the Rosary. The Third Luminous Mystery is from Mark, the words the minister says when imposing ashes on your forehead on Ash Wednesday: "Repent and believe in the Gospel."

The lesson is simple but powerful. The Lord Jesus calls and if we listen, we change our ways into a new life in Christ.

Please do so!




Blessed Palms for Ashes


