

NOURISH



FROM THE DESK OF FR. PETER...

Friends,

Today we celebrate the Fifth Sunday of Lent. We have all been trying to be good. We have been faithful in our devotions, saying our rosary and imploring Divine Mercy, abstaining from all the things we like most. By now, we should be feeling very holy. But instead, we are still flopping around trying to understand if we are any better now than we were five weeks ago? The readings on this Fifth Sunday aim to enlighten and help us in our guest for holiness. The readings address the struggle between good and evil, which comes up in many forms: the body and soul, flesh and spirit, good and evil, life and death, God and Satan. So, what does it mean to be holy?

The prophet Ezekiel from our first reading announces the future of the Israelites while they were in exile. He describes how God will bring them out of the grave and infuse the spirit of life into them so that they are truly one with HIM. This promise remains true for all of us today. At times, we, too, can be "spiritually exiled and separated from God."

In the second reading, when Paul wrote to the Romans, he refers to "the flesh" as sin itself. He does not mean our bodies are sinful, but that sinfulness can permeate us. Paul calls it "living in the flesh." We are all called to live in the Spirit, to be good, to be holy. And without the

Spirit of God living within us, one is no different from being dead. Paul emphasizes that only the spirit of Jesus can restore us to life. Jesus is God Incarnate – God enfleshed – and it is to Him we must look to help us find true holiness.

In our Gospel story for this Sunday, we listen to the story of Jesus bringing Lazarus back from the grave to a life of grace. The story is long and contains many details, just as our lives are also a bit complicated. Most of us by now have survived many Lents; we know each one of the many events, large and small, that we experience in our lives reveal something to us or about us.

The actions and words of Jesus in our story and those of the disciples, the behavior of Martha and Mary and their friends, are similar to those in our everyday lives. And we know how others can interpret them. But our Scripture readings for this Fifth Sunday clearly reveal that the God in all three readings is the same God, the ONE who gives life to the body, who brings us back from the grave, who frees us from our sinfulness, thus making us saintly. By infusing his Spirit "Life" into us, Jesus redeems and saves us.

One great consoling truth we receive from today's readings, my dear people, is that Love is the source of miracles: "The man you love is ill." Despite all the distractions in our lives, and regardless of our many weaknesses and multiple failures, God in Christ Jesus shares with us His Spirit and restores our lives. Holiness is revealed, so as to love and be loved by God and others.


