

FROM THE DESK OF DCN. CHUCK...

A recent survey by Gallup has found that less than 48% of the US population attends a church, synagogue or a mosque. That is

down 20 percentage points from 20 years ago. Why has that happened?

In today's world, while we cannot literally deliver Christ up for death, we can deliver him figuratively. Very few people today do not have the opportunity to know the truth. However, we see more and more that people are denying him by their actions and words.

Our government leaders, at many levels, like to dress up proposed laws in pretty-sounding names. Remember the Recovery Act to help in fighting the pandemic and ensuring people had a safety net? About 90% of the money was directed to items other than pandemic-specific work.

Right now, our leaders in Washington, D.C. and Sacramento are formulating laws that threaten our faith and our religious tenets. Please review Cardinal Timothy Dolan's article in the Catholic Voice of March 22, 2021. He explains why the Equity Act currently before Congress, while sounding righteous, is more like a wolf in sheep's clothing. Are we repeating what occurred 2000 years ago? Peter sternly tells the people in today's reading from Acts that they have denied and put Christ to death by their actions or lack of actions. They have brought this about by their ignorance and the ignorance of their leaders. The guestion is – How did that ignorance come about?

Ignorance occurs for one of two reasons: either (1) the person does not know the truth because of lack of opportunity; or (2) the person decides to not know or believe the truth.

Let's not be ignorant as to what is happening in today's world. Stop putting Christ in the back seat or in the closet. Let's start putting him in the driver's seat and allow him to take us with him. Keep your faith alive and active by becoming knowledgeable about our world and the forces that are trying to remove God from our lives. When appropriate, contact your elected representatives and voice your opinion. If they do not listen, you have the choice at the next election. Please use it to protect and defend your religious liberties.



Catholic Church law requires baptized Catholics to marry before a Catholic priest or deacon. In Catholic tradition, the vows exchanged by the couple are a sacred pact between each other with Christ as their partner. Studies have shown that couples who recognize God's presence in their relationships experience greater contentment and are more likely to have a lifelong marriage. Couples who bring their marriage into the Church welcome God's grace and special blessings upon their marriage. If your vows were exchanged in the presence of ministers from other religious traditions or civil officials, we invite you to bring new meaning to your relationship by embracing the vocation of marriage. 
