

FROM THE DESK OF DN. STEVE...

Some regard Pentecost as the birthday of our Church, when Jesus sends the Holy Spirit to the apostles as Advocate, the Spirit of Truth.

In today's Gospel, Jesus appeared in the Upper Room to the disciples who were hiding in fear and confusion. He breathed on them and said, "Receive the Holy Spirit."

In the first reading, the Holy Spirit came upon the 12 apostles, appearing to them as "tongues of fire." Because of this, the color for Pentecost is red and is often symbolized with fire. This is why we wear red at mass today!

We receive the Holy Spirit when we accept Christ. The word Christian actually means Christ in us. The special thing about having the Holy Spirit is that God never leaves us so we can talk to Him or ask for help anytime.

The Holy Spirit helps us in many ways; the Spirit comforts, teaches, helps us grow in our relationship with God, and gives us strength to get rid of the bad habits in our lives. The Spirit also gives us the power that helps us know when we've done something wrong. The Holy Spirit really works within us.

The Holy Spirit makes the impossible possible. It reminds us that it does not require great people to do great things, just unselfish ones. God is alive and visible through the talents that we put into action, gifts which are given to us through the Holy Spirit.

Let's now go out and show our sisters and brothers the Love from Jesus and the gifts of the Holy Spirit. Just like the twelve disciples, the Holy Spirit helps us with conquering our own fears and sending us out to continue God's mission. We prepare the soil; The Spirit grows the seed.

Lastly, from my heart – I want to say thank you, from Annette and me, for all your prayers, gifts, cards, meals, conversations, fellowship, and bringing us the Eucharist each Sunday. It truly shows me how blessed I am to have such a beautiful, loving family here at Holy Spirit and beyond. For anyone who may not know, I had a ladder slip out from under me; I broke ribs and fractured parts of my lower back. Then five weeks later, my gallbladder decided it wanted to come out. I am still healing. I hope and pray to be able to serve you, my sisters and brothers, soon.

I pray that the Holy Spirit continues to guide you on your spiritual journey toward Heaven.



Recognize God In Your Ordinary Moments

You Don't Have What It Takes - but You Will

Those of us in ministry love this saying: God doesn't call the equipped. He equips the called.

We all know that sort of queasy feeling we get in the pit of our stomachs when it becomes clear what we're supposed to do, in any situation. It's that feeling of: Oh, no. Not me. Not now. I can't.

We've all got our list of reasons why not, don't we? We do it for everything, from big life problems to small everyday choices. I'm not going to invite my neighbor to church because I don't want to come across as pushy. I'm not going to make amends with my cousin because she'll just walk all over me again. I'm not going to say a Rosary tonight because I'm tired and it'll just stress me out.

However, even if we all put our lists of "reasons why we can't" together, I don't think any of us have reasons quite as valid as the apostles. Their job was to convert the nations — and here they are, a bunch of fishermen who haven't been out of Judea, who speak only their own languages. Were they supposed to preach the Gospel via a particularly compelling game of charades?

But even that big, giant, stop-you-dead-in-your tracks Reason Why We Can't was nothing, because God had a plan. He didn't call a bunch of equipped men. He called them, and He equipped them. Cue the tongues of fire!

God doesn't call us to do His will because we have what it takes. He calls us because He's ready to give us what it takes. Being a good steward is to answer the call of Christ knowing he will provide.


