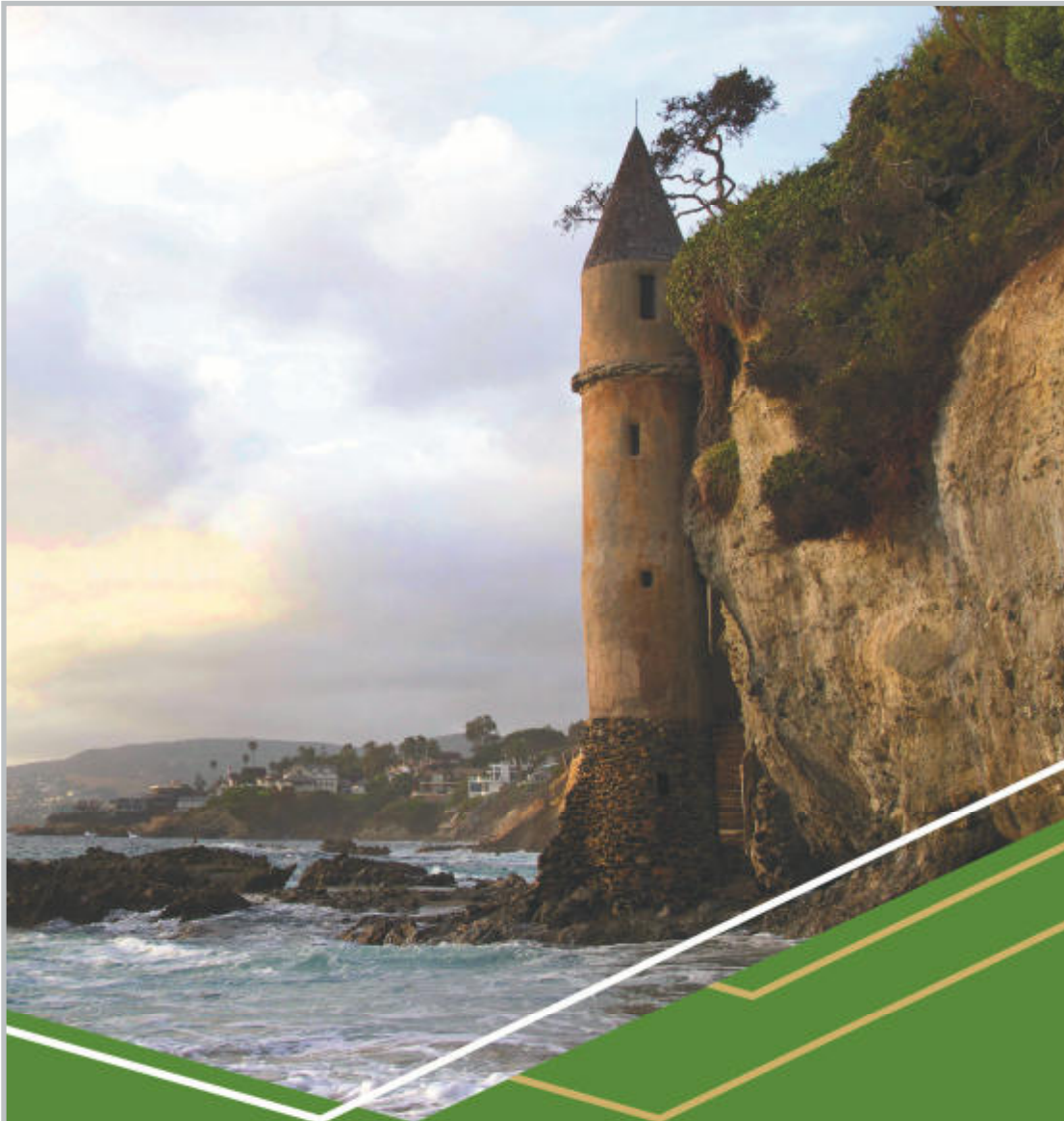

FROM THE DESK OF DN. RIGO...

Today we listen attentively to both Paul and Mark...

On the one hand we have Paul letting us into a big secret: **“old things have passed away; new things have come”** Why? Simply because **“whoever is in Christ is a new creation...”**

Then Mark informs us that Jesus is perfectly capable of directing the wind to do what He says. Not only that, but He also asks His disciples why they do not have faith: **“Why are you terrified? Do you not yet have faith?”**

That question, my friends, is directed to His disciples, some of them are here in the church today. We gather every Sunday to listen attentively to the Word proclaimed and explained, and then eat and drink of the Most Precious Body and Blood of the Lord. However, do we truly have faith in Him? Let us be truly a new creation in Christ and let us help others do the same...

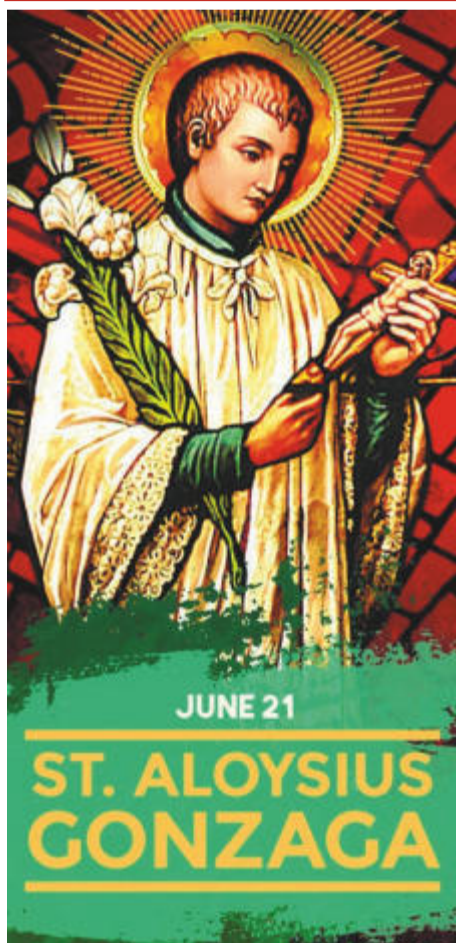

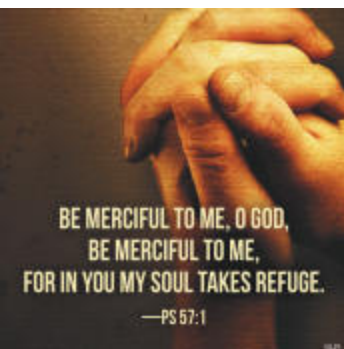

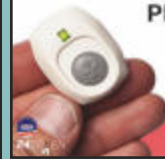
