FROM THE DESK OF DN. BERNARD...

"Crab Mentality or Crab Effect"

When crabs are placed in a bucket, there is a natural tendency for them to climb their way out of the bucket. While any of them could easily escape one at a time, its efforts become difficult because others pull them down, inevitably ensuring the group's collective demise.

In the human sense, when members of the same group attempt to reduce, or discredit the advancement or success of another person, they do so purely out of envy. Selfishness or resentment come to the surface through downplaying, criticism, discouragement, and unkind actions. (All of these are the very same attitudes that caused Jesus His death.)

"Familiarity Breeds Contempt"

Extensive knowledge of or close association with a person/situation can easily lead to a loss of respect for that person or carelessness in that particular situation.

This was very true for the townsmen of Jesus of Nazareth, and it is still true for many of us today. Do we really appreciate the spiritual beauty of those close to us? Sometimes when we say to close friends, coworkers, social groups, or even our own family members that we serve at church, they are turned off and we often hear some discouraging remarks from them.

The Ten Commandments of God specifically tell us that before all others, God is to be the utmost first, but society discredits this, even in our very own Christian world. We tend to discredit God and put Him on the side. Even when we know that we are going against God, but we still deviate from His commands to suit our own needs and satisfaction. This is simply a way of rejecting God.

"Jesus was amazed at their lack of faith"

God does not look at familiarity or social status, but desires our faithfulness. Having faith is believing, trusting, relying on God in everything and in every situation.

We tend to look for God elsewhere when, in fact, God is inside each and every one of us. He waits for us to unbox our hearts, to open and welcome Him.

In Jesus, the people of Nazareth could have seen their potential. They could have praised God for raising a prophet in Jesus from among them. And with Jesus as an example, they could have proven that, indeed, good things can come from Nazareth. Instead, they simply confined themselves to where they were. As the saying goes, "If I can't have it, neither should you!" We, too, must look beyond ourselves, beyond our poverty and limitations.



Did you know...about NFP?

Natural Family Planning or NFP is an important element in married relationships of Catholic couples. NFP Awareness Week is July 25-31, and leading up to that week, we're bringing you a short fact about NFP each week!

Natural Family Planning is the use of a Fertility Awareness Based Method alongside continual prayer and discernment with your spouse on family size. Fertility Awareness Based Methods use signs charted throughout the woman's cycle to identify times of relative fertility and infertility. A typical cycle begins with a time of infertility, followed by a time of fertility, followed by another time of infertility. This repeats on a cyclical basis. Fertility Awareness Based Methods are evidence-based scientific methods of tracking female fertility that a couple can use as a part of NFP within their marriage.
