

This weekend's Gospel of Mark 6:7-13 brought me back to my childhood. Everything seemed so simple when I was growing up.

We would go out and play and not worry about food or money. If we got thirsty, we would drink water from one of our neighbors' hoses in front of their house. Shoes were an option, maybe because we only had one pair. And when we played outside, our imaginations ran wild.

The world we live in today is very different. Most kids carry a cell phone, water bottle, money, and a carefully orchestrated outfit. The tennis shoes today are expensive and a status symbol. Today's kids play, connect, or communicate with their electronic devices, or under adult supervision. Our kids live in a controlled and materialistic world. Ever thought maybe we do, too?

If Jesus summoned us to follow HIM, what would we carry with us? Could we leave behind

our cell phones, our water bottles, our money, and all our materialistic items we hold so tightly, and think our needs are fulfilled? Personally, I am already in trouble. I will have to go and buy a pair of sandals, since I no longer own a pair.

We need to rely on God and God only. Remember, all our earthly possessions cannot go with us to Heaven. God has given each of us a mission in life to help our brothers and sisters in their faith. We need to be examples to show them the love God has for each of us. We are asked to be the kids of old, with nothing tying us down. Remember the words: "no worries."

Let us get off the grid and not be so caught up with material things. Let our faith in God lead us. Let us enjoy being around people who like us for who we are, and stop being something we are not.

Let the Holy Spirit fill our lives.





Did you know...about NFP?

Natural Family Planning (NFP) is an important element in the married relationships of Catholic Couples. It allows for a natural way for married couples to space pregnancies.

Pope Paul VI said it best in Humanae Vitae, "If therefore there are well-grounded reasons for spacing births, arising from the physical or psychological condition of husband or wife, or from external circumstances, the Church teaches that married people may then take advantage of the natural cycles immanent in the reproductive system and engage in marital intercourse only during those times that are infertile." (HV, paragraph 16)

Using the science of fertility, couples can effectively space pregnancies when needed. Some ask, what is a "well-grounded" reason for spacing a pregnancy? The Church doesn't have a list because answering that question depends on prayer, discernment and communication with your spouse.
