

FROM THE DESK OF FR. KEN...

My Dear Brothers and Sisters,

Have you ever longed for a role, a job, or place in life that you would

give just about anything to have it? And then, after you finally get what you wanted, you realize you bit off way more than you can chew?

In today's Gospel, two of Jesus' disciples ask for a huge role—to partake of Jesus' passion and death and sit at his right and left side in his eternal kingdom. However, they have no idea the suffering that they would be partaking in to have this desire fulfilled.

With gentleness and love, Jesus tells them He will give them some of what they ask for, but not all. Hearing that we can't do it all or have it all requires deep humility.

Are you ready to put on profound humility?

The message of the Gospel is uncomfortable. It goes against the grain of our deep-seated human attitude to be told to serve rather than to be served, to be willing to spare others by not sparing ourselves for the good of others, and to give up the urge for power.

But this is the hard truth with which Christ has confronted us today. Like Jesus, then, let us put on profound humility in our homes, in our communities, in the Church, and to spend ourselves for others.

HERE'S THE SITCH...

We still have the following new stained-glass windows available for sponsorship:

- Modesty, Gentleness, Self-Control, Chastity these are \$10,000 each to sponsor and receive a dedication on the glass for you, your family, or ministry group.
- South side windows next to the side entrance door (below the large "Holy Spirit" window) they are \$12,000 for the narrow and \$15,000 for the wide to sponsor and get a dedication on the glass for you, your family, or group.
- Also available are newly installed vertical stained-glass windows flanking the St. John's side entrance doors. The two inner windows are still available for \$12,000 each. These windows have the "Seven Gifts of the Holy Spirit" (3 Gifts listed on inner windows) as well as a dedication on the glass for you, your family, or group.
- Finally, we have two newly installed windows in the Choir Area with the musical staff and cross flanking the side entrance door. The upper is \$12,000 and the lower is \$5,000 and has the dedication space on each.


