FROM THE DESK OF DN. RIGO...

The readings for this weekend are all about consolation, belonging, and being part of the TEAM...

The first reading talks about a God who is so merciful that He is the Father of the people, of the nation, and brings them back from exile.

The Gospel shows us how Jesus is full of mercy for the blind man who humbly begs to see. When Bartimaeus hears that Jesus is passing by, he calls us to Jesus from a place of faith, deep faith: "Jesus, son of David, have pity on me."

I want that much faith for me, and I pray often to be given such a gift that I can implore Jesus' mercy in the same way that Bartimaeus does, with certainty but with humility. He is not arrogant or demanding; he simply begs, and Jesus gives him what he needs – health. In return, Bartimaeus follows Jesus.

Would you be able to do such a thing?

In the second reading, God the Father calls on Jesus and us, too: "You are my son, this day I have begotten you...You are a priest forever to the order of Melchizedek." He calls us to be with Him, to be one with the Father just as the Father and Son are one.

Let us live as one, in unity of faith and purpose: to praise, to worship, to serve God the Father in the unity of the Son and with the Spirit. Let us call on Mary Most Holy to be our support, that thru her prayer at the foot of the Cross we may be able to achieve the purpose for which we were created.


