### FROM THE DESK OF DN. CHUCK...

This week we celebrate the Solemnity of Christ the King. The Feast of Christ the King was established in 1925 by Pope Pius XI.

Proclaiming loud and clear that Christ is King over all people would help bring the faithful back into the Church from their move towards secularism in their lives. Not only for the faithful, but also the Church leaders who had become more nationalistic in their dealings with one another. A reminder was needed that Christ's royalty extended over individuals, families, society, governments, and nations.

The Feast day was originally celebrated on the last Sunday of October. In 1969, Pope Paul VI moved the date to the last Sunday of the Liturgical Year and elevated it to a Solemnity.

Looking at it in different ways, the placing of the celebration at this time makes a lot of sense. Being at the end of the yearly cycle when we are studying the end times (eschatology – a big word in Greek that refers to the study of the end) helps us to remember that at the end of time, we will all be with the King in the form of the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.

We also can take the position that we have studied and prayed throughout the year to lift our faith to the level of accepting Christ as Priest, Prophet and King. Now as the year ends, we should have reached that point. Next week, we start the year over again with the first Sunday of Advent.

Today we are reminded that while we have different layers of family, society, and government, Christ is King of us all and our first loyalty is to be with him.

If we are able to put him first, our families and all of society will be in a much better place.
