

FROM THE DESK OF FR. KEN...

The First Sunday of Advent marks the beginning of a new liturgical year. At the outset, why does the Gospel focus on endings as it talks about the sun

and moon darkening, and the stars falling from the sky? We are supposed to be preparing to celebrate Jesus' birth as the Messiah, not hear about the end of the world. What's going on here?

Much of the world is sitting in the dark of hunger, suffering, and violence, and yet, because we are God's people and followers of Jesus, we keep up the indestructible hope that truth, goodness, and justice will prevail.

For we believe that Christ our Lord has come and is alive among us. We struggle, we know the road is rough, but the Lord goes with us and He tells us: "Come with me, serve with me, love with me, give and share yourself with me, and you will be better, and the Church and the world will be better."

The first reading reminds us to keep hope alive. To a discouraged people, the prophet announces: Take courage! A Savior will come from the house of David. With him, honesty and integrity will make a new beginning.

The second reading speaks to us about preparing for the Lord's coming. Jesus came to make us new. By growing in love and living our faith more deeply, we hasten his coming in our world.

The Gospel admonishes us that even in times of danger, we keep hoping in the future by living a life of love, prayer, and vigilance – we prepare to meet the Lord.




Christmas Baby
