

FROM THE DESK OF DN. RIGO...

The psalm tells us: "The Lord has done great things for us; we are filled with joy."

And indeed, the Lord has done great things for us! He has sent His messenger, John the Baptist, ahead of His only Son, Jesus Christ to proclaim a baptism of repentance and to prepare the way of the Lord so all flesh may see the salvation of God.

In this waiting moment for the Second Coming of Jesus, when we are also waiting for Christmas to arrive, are you joyful? Have you repented for your sin(s)? If you answered "yes" to these two questions, what actions and behaviors have you taken on to bring about the kingdom of God into your household and your workplace?

If you have not found reason to repent, you may need spiritual guidance. I do not know one single human that does not need to repent; we all have something to talk about with a confessor (I recommend you do). Take advantage of Thursdays during Advent to find a priest here at HSC to confess your sin(s) and come clean to the Lord.

If you are not joyful, seek a spiritual guide. He or she may be able to assist you and get you turned around so that you may find reason(s) to be joyful.

I can assist you in finding a priest for the Sacrament of Reconciliation or somebody to provide you with spiritual guidance. Come talk to me, my office is always open.


Join us immediately after the Simbang Gabi Mass for our Annual Tree Lighting event.
