The Visitation

Growing up, I was always told to never make impulse decisions so as to avoid consequences.

Mary went in haste to visit her cousin Elizabeth.

In haste? Yes, she went without any reservations at all. Sometimes doing things in haste can be a good thing. In the case of Mary, aside from her desire to visit and help Elizabeth who was advanced in years, went in haste to share her joy about the miracle of her own unexpected pregnancy. She was the very first to share the good news of the promise of a Messiah being fulfilled.

There are several Gospel accounts wherein haste leads to a glorious encounter.

Mary's visit with Elizabeth becomes a joyful exchange not only between Mary and Elizabeth but with Jesus and John as well... At the sound of Mary's voice, the baby in Elizabeth's womb leaped with joy and Elizabeth was filled with the Holy Spirit.

After the shepherds were visited by the Angel of the Lord and were told of what had taken place, they went in haste to visit the Holy Family and were amazed. They returned glorifying and praising God for all they had heard and seen.

When was the last time we went in haste to visit a dear friend, a sick relative or an elderly person who needed company, to console a grieving family, or to listen to stranger who needed to be heard? Was there a time when we made ourselves completely available to others in their loneliness?

A visit doesn't require much, and it doesn't even have to be costly. Your mere presence is the very gift that you can give. It is the giving of oneself for the other that makes that moment special (resplendent of Jesus' giving of Himself for us all).

How often do we visit the Divine Presence of God in the Blessed Tabernacle? Jesus is constantly waiting for us to visit Him.

Much like Mary and the shepherds' encounters, in our own visitations, especially those in line with the corporal works of mercy, we certainly bring God's joyful presence to others, though we may not realize it at times.

God speaks to us not only through scripture but also through the people and events we meet in our everyday life. But to see the hands of God, we need to encounter others with the eyes of faith knowing that every moment is a moment of God's grace working in our lives.

Christmas is to celebrate Jesus' arrival into our lives and share His gift of peace, love, joy, and hope to all.

Take a moment this Christmas season and visit those who are most in need. Surely you will be sharing the joy of the season, not with material gifts, but with the gift of God's grace working through you.




