Second Sunday in Ordinary Time

Today we listen to a description of the gifts that the Holy Spirit gives

the faithful for the benefit of the church...

We have all received these gifts, and we are called to freely give them away as freely as they have been given to us...

When we use them, the church becomes strong and the mission of Jesus to reconcile the world to the Father becomes real in the here and now...

So, it begs the question: Do you know what gift the Holy Spirit gave you? Have you ever explored the gift, developed it, and used it to bring others to Christ, to help the church grow in the Spirit? We have developed a process here at Holy Spirit Church to help you with this endeavor, to aid you in finding what your Spirit-freely given gift is, then explore and develop it so we, as an AMAZING Parish, may help Fremont become a Spirit filled community.

In the Gospel, Jesus makes His first sign, thus revealing Himself as the Son of God, the Messiah promised by the Father to reconcile the world to the Father.

Jesus shows us that by using the gifts the Holy Spirit freely bestows on us, we reveal the Father to the world and we are brought closer to the Father, so we may be one church just as the Father and Jesus are one.

"The Spirit himself is 'God's gift' par excellence (cf. John 4:10), a gift from God, and in turn communicates different spiritual gifts to those who welcome him." - Pope Francis

The greatest gift of the Holy Spirit is the Holy Spirit. The living God gives the gift of himself to those who are baptized. From the Spirit flows other gifts, some of which are for our personal sanctification while others are for the building up and support of the body of Christ. Many of the gifts are very familiar to us (wisdom, counsel, love) while others are somewhat foreign (healing, prophecy, tongues). Whatever our experience, the gifts of the Holy Spirit are for all Christians, and no one should think that the gifts are not for them. Jesus did this as the beginning of his signs at Cana in Galilee and so revealed his glory, and his disciples began to believe in him.






