



Dear Holy Spirit Family,

On this third Sunday in Ordinary time, in our first reading, the prophet has


gathered all the men, women and children who can understand, around him. He goes to a lot of trouble to make sure that they can see him and hear him as he reads out loud to them the word of God. Our God wants each of us to know that the words of Scripture are for everyone, without exception. For Our God is loving, generous, and merciful. We should feel and spend time rejoicing in the love and goodness that God has and showers on each one of us.

Paul, in his letter to the Corinthians, is also reminding us how every gift we receive, every talent each of us possesses, are given to be used not only for our own personal good; instead, we become more fruitful when we joyfully share them with others. We should always remember that when we share lovingly with others, the graces multiply. We must also rejoice that other people are gifted in different ways so we may all profit as a result. God showers His gifts on us so that we share. These same gifts increase. Instead of giving way to feelings of envy, we should be rejoicing in the gifts of others.

In the Gospel reading for this Sunday, Luke is assuring us, as he recounts the story of the life of Jesus, that everyone will be enlightened, be full of joy and gratitude. Luke concludes by telling them, "Today this scripture is fulfilled in your hearing." We, too, in this New Year must welcome the story of the life of Jesus and allow the love and joy of the scripture to be fulfilled in us and our children.

- Sundays, 12:00 to 5:00 pm



Pay attention to the sender's email and the subject line. Please do not respond to emails that claim to come from our clergy or staff.

#### Bring Your Marriage into the Church: Group Convalidation

Catholic Church law requires baptized Catholics to marry before a Catholic priest or deacon. In Catholic tradition, the vows exchanged by the couple are a sacred pact between each other with Christ as their partner. Studies have shown that couples who recognize God's presence in their relationships experience greater contentment and are more likely to have a lifelong marriage. Couples who bring their marriage into the Church welcome God's grace and special blessings upon their marriage. If your vows were exchanged in the presence of ministers from other religious traditions or civil officials, we invite you to bring new meaning to your relationship by embracing the vocation of marriage. 
