

FROM THE DESK OF DN. RIGO...

I have wondered at times: Who am I? What is my purpose? Am I doing what I am supposed to? And if so, how well am I doing it?

These questions come to mind often, not that I second guess myself. Just that my father made me question my motives often and check myself against the moral values he instilled in me. So also my spiritual guide(s), all of them at different moments of my life have asked me the same questions directly or a variation of them.

And you? Does that happen to you too? Do the answers satisfy you or let you know that you are short of the mark?

Remember that "from the fullness of your heart your mouth speaks." (Luke 6:45)

I invite you to do the Examen daily, 15 minutes will suffice. Just be in the moment and take time

to converse with the Lord. Let Him know how much you long for Him, that you want to be in His presence and desire His guidance. Review the events of the previous day, then check what is it you did right and thank the Lord for it. Review what you could have done better but did not and ask the Lord forgiveness, then ask for His help in the ensuing 24 hours and end with thanking Him for walking with you one more day. Repeat the next day.

If you need more information, come to the De Sousa House. I will be honored. Let us have a cup of coffee, enjoy a moment together and talk, converse, engage.

I recommend that you go into FORMED and peek at this: <u>The Search: Episode 1</u>

This series will assist you in finding out what is it you seek, get to know yourself a little better so you may in turn talk to the Lord and open your heart and mind to what He has to say to you. And if you need a little more help, I am at the de Sousa House ready to serve you.


