

FROM THE DESK OF FR. PFTFR...

Friends.

Welcome to the first week of our Lenten Time!

When I was a child, I loved other seasons like Advent, Christmas, Easter, but Lent was not my favorite season. The parish priest where I grew up was always reminding us to give up the very things that we enjoyed the most, e.g., chocolate, meat, ice cream and. Also, there were no colorful decorations in the church during this time, no flowers, our church looking very sparse and dreary. On top of that, we were expected to do penances which were not my favorite pastime.

But, as I grew up, I left my childish ways behind, and I hope gracefully learned to appreciate and enjoy the temper of Lent.

The primary purpose of Lent is to prepare ourselves for the celebration of Jesus' Death and Resurrection. The Church invites us all to enter into the 'desert' experience like Jesus and the people of Israel to "reorder our priorities"; to redirect our values, ideals, and ambitions through fasting, prayer, and almsgiving.

Lent is the season when journey hand-in-hand with God in a very special way as He helps us

overcome whatever temptations and struggles that we are facing in our lives.

In our Gospel today, Jesus is led into the desert to pray. And in this experience, like all of us, Jesus, too, experiences temptations and is tested. There are three temptations (or the three "P's") that are mentioned in the scripture, namely: PLEASURE ("Command this stone to become bread"); POSSESSION ("All this will be yours, if you worship me"); and POWER ("If you are the son of God, throw yourself down from here"). Jesus perseveres and overcomes all these temptations.

We, too, can easily and unconsciously fall into these three P's. In this first week of Lent, let us allow the Holy Spirit to lead us into the desert and to turn Lent into a time for spiritual growth, to recognize what in our lives that needs to be healed, to be reordered, and to be redirected.

Also, let us fast, not only from food and material stuff that we enjoy, but more importantly to stop hating, causing division, being envious, giving way to anger, and being over critical.


May our loving Christ continue to Journey with you today and every day. Amen!


