

FROM THE DESK OF DN. STEVE...

When I read the Gospel for today, it brought back the memories. I first heard this story from Deacon Steve Taylor here at Holy Spirit Church,

and then later Father Mathew Vellankal would always have this story in his Homily at Lent. I actually teared up as I remembered how he would always laugh even before the punch line.

There was a painter who was always cheating his customers by thinning down his paint to make it go further. He bid on a painting job at a church and won with the lowest bid. Well – as usual he thinned out the paint with turpentine.

As he neared the end of the project, there was a clap of thunder and a heavy downpour of rain. The thin paint washed away, and he was knocked off the scaffolding. He knew this was a judgment from the Almighty, so he fell on his knees and cried: "Oh God! Forgive me! What should I do?" A mighty voice spoke: "Repaint! Repaint, and thin no more!"

This Lent, if you have not already done so, repent for your sins through the Sacrament of Reconciliation. For we do not know the hour, but we can be prepared the best we can.

The Responsorial Psalm for this Sunday (Year C) says it the best:


Film Screening: "Bridge of Roses: Story of Our Lady of the Cape"


