

FROM THE DESK OF DN. CHUCK...

"Lazarus, come out!"

With these words, Jesus brings back to life his friend. This is not

a resurrection. Jesus has prepared us for this moment, not only earlier in the Gospel message of today, but also in Chapter 5 of John.

In Chapter 5, we hear Jesus say, "Just as the Father raises the dead and gives them life, so also the Son gives life to whomever he wishes. I tell you, the hour is coming when the dead will hear the voice of the Son of God, and those who hear will live. The hour is coming when all who are in their graves will hear his voice and will come out."

And now Martha says to Jesus, "I know he will rise, in the resurrection on the last day." Then Jesus responds, "I am the resurrection and the life. Whoever believes in me, even if he dies, will live, and everyone who lives and believes in me will never die."

Jesus did not call Lazarus out alone. He did all of this in front of those who followed him to Bethany as well as those who were present with Martha and Mary. He wanted all to see the Glory of God at work.

Just as Thomas had to see to believe after the Resurrection, the crowd around the grave of Lazarus saw the Glory of God in person. Their witnessing of these events and spreading the word to others will build the momentum for the adulation of Christ next week when he enters Jerusalem.



2021 PARISH FINANCE REPORT



Following is a summary of Holy Spirit's financials for the 2021 fiscal year. Despite being the second year of the pandemic, our financials continue to be well managed under the direction of Fr. Ken Sales and the staff. Our commitment is to continue to be transparent with the financials of our parish and we thank you for the ongoing and continued support of Holy Spirit. It is through your generosity we can have such a vibrant parish. We budgeted conservatively for 2021 given there were many unknowns. Holy Spirit continues to be in good financial health. Some key highlights of the 2021 Financials:

Income

- Total Income was greater than budget by \$446K
- Plate collections were higher than budget by \$111K
- Gifts and one-time donations were higher than budget by \$138K
- Other Income & Parish Share was higher than budget by \$197k. Other income includes Facilities Use, Bishops Appeal Rebate (amount over Bishops Appeal target) and the PPP (paycheck protection program) loan forgiveness..

Expenses:

- Expenses were and continue to be well managed as the Parish staff was very conservative in their spend with the unknowns of the pandemic.
- Total Expense was just over budget by \$14K. This also includes depreciation, a non-cash expense of \$453K shown in the Parish Property expense category
- Net Operating Income /Loss
 - For the 2021 fiscal year, Holy Spirit shows a profit of \$57K.
- Key Projects and Achievements
 - Most major capital projects were deferred for 2021.
 - Some of the key projects for 2021 include:
 - Campus Master planning Committee and Program Teams were established to plan Holy Spirit Campus
 - Topographic Survey of the Campus was completed
 - Sr Asha Kooliyadan converted to full time for Parish and School
 - PA system/water filling station/paint gym (grants)
 - Exercise room for clergy in residence

Other Income and Expense

- This year, we have also included income and expense that were managed by key ministries and any one-time grants
- Total Income and Expense are listed below the target of these ministries is to manage to a break even over time.


