The three readings this Sunday are in synergy...

In the first reading from Genesis, Abraham negotiates with the Lord for His mercy and finally gets the Lord to reduce the number of holy people needed to stave off the punishment of both Sodom and Gomorrah...

The second reading from Colossians lets us know that Jesus' sacrifice and eventual resurrection forgives our own transgressions...

These transgressions are alluded to in the Lord's Prayer that Jesus teaches His disciples as they ask for guidance in the art and science of prayer... Finally, the great lesson of Jesus gives us the code on how to become not just a follower, a disciple, but an intentional one at that, to be humble enough to do this: ASK!


