

FROM THE DESK OF FR. PETER...

Dear Holy Spirit Family,

The gospel on this eighteenth Sunday in ordinary time invites us to ask:

"How can we become rich in the eyes of God?"

The parable in our gospel today reminds us to look at everything as a gift! Even the fruits of our labors, what we have accomplished, what we have amassed, is a gift from God. Our very life itself, our 'soul' in the language of the parable, is a gift from God that is given to us on loan.

The man in the parable lost sight of that truth; he talked as if he possessed even his own soul. It actually belonged to God and God called it back at a time that the man did not expect.

If everything is a gift, then we have to hold it lightly. We hold it, while looking towards the God who gave us what we have, and while looking towards others who can benefit from what we have received. Every gift implies some responsibility. Every grace makes some call on us.


Here at the Holy Spirit parish, people give back in all sorts of ways from what they received. It doesn't always mean giving back in a financial sense; but many people have shared their expertise, their time, experience, and service. So much of what is good in our communities is the fruit of such unpaid service, of that generous giving to God and to the community, out of an appreciation for all that has been received.

St. Paul, in today's second reading, associates greed with what he calls the "OLD SELF", and he calls on us to keep putting on the "NEW SELF" which he identifies as a self that is in the image of its creator. Jesus Christ is the perfect image of God the creator, a perfect example for us.

The NEW SELF that we are called to put on and keep on every day is the giving of ourselves. To be rich in the eyes of God, one must empty oneself, like Christ, so that the lives of others might be enriched.

HERE'S THE WORD...

A Brief Commentary on the Gospel

The Theme of the Readings: What Makes Life Meaningful?

The Bible teaches that life extends beyond the temporal world; therefore, our lives only make sense if we can relate it to lasting values. If we only focus on values that perish, we make no lasting contribution.

In the First Reading, the inspired writer tells us that material wealth, earthly wisdom, and its illusion of prosperity are all in vain; these are temporal works that are fleeting and without a real purpose or lasting reward. It is only when we relate our lives to God by building a relationship with Him in prayer and worship, by coming to understand His divine plan for humanity through the study of Sacred Scripture, and by sharing God's love for us with others that we can say we invested our efforts in a worthwhile life.

The First Reading prepares us for our Gospel Reading. Jesus tells the Parable of the Rich Fool to demonstrate the foolishness of striving for the material over the spiritual. His message is that temporal life is fleeting, and we cannot store up earthly treasures for our hoped-for heavenly future. It is the accumulation of works of love and mercy that pleases God. They are credited toward eternal life and recorded in the Lord's Books of Deeds that will be laid open at the Final Judgment.

People who only run after material goods and mortal values that perish will never be satisfied. Life becomes meaningful when it is related to God in prayer and worship and to others in the human family to whom we demonstrate God's love. It is then that life has meaning because we have God's forgiveness of our sins and the hope of eternal salvation through Christ Jesus; it is our petition in the opening prayer: "Forgive us our sins and restore us to life. Keep us safe in your love. Grant this through our Lord Jesus Christ, your Son, who lives and reigns with you and the Holy Spirit, one God, forever and ever. Amen."

This Sunday's readings teach us that temporal life is fleeting, and it is only our deeds of righteousness that have lasting value. At the end of our lives, when we come before God to face divine judgment, He will open the Book of Deeds that contains a record of our generous works of compassion and mercy: and a record book was written before him of those who fear the LORD and trust in his name.

It is the accumulation of good works that please God and which He credits toward our reward of eternal life. It is the richness of those selfless acts of love and mercy in service to Christ upon which one's life will be judged (Mt 25:31-46; Rev 20:11-12), and provides the answer to the question, "What makes life meaningful?"

"And the Word was made flesh, and dwelt among us."


