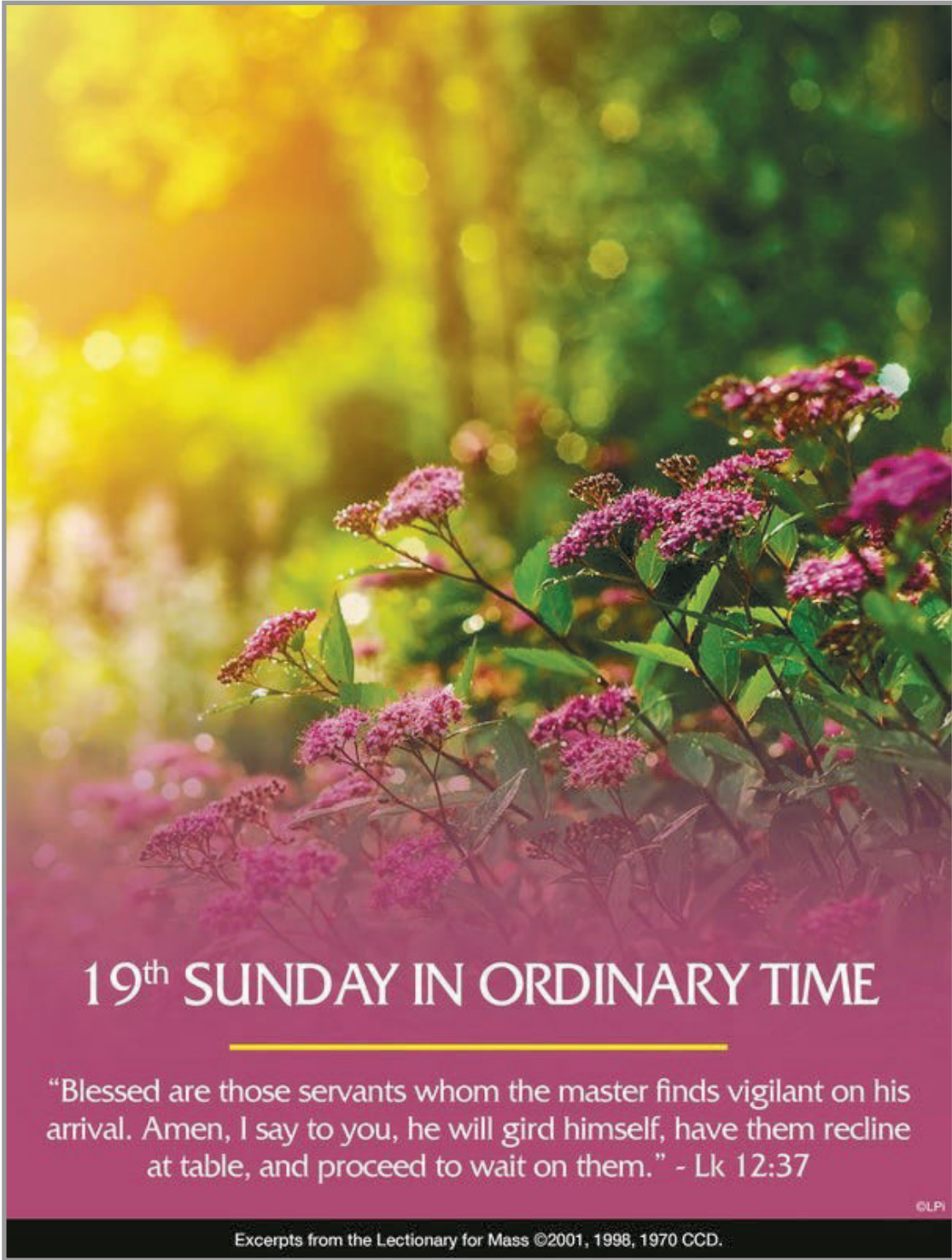

## FROM THE DESK OF DN. BERNARD...

Vigilant and Faithful Servants.

To be a Christian is to be always vigilant to hear the Word and respond to God's will.

When it comes to serving God and serving the church, there is always that feeling of hesitance or resistance. Sometimes we are invited to join a certain ministry because others see something in us but still, we decline the invitation because of one of the following reasons.

"I'm not good enough!" (*Didn't Jesus choose ordinary people to be His Apostles?*)

"I don't think it's for me!" (*Aren't we called by our baptism?*)

"Not now because I'm very busy at the moment, but when I retire, I'll have the time to serve." (*What if that time never comes? Why prolong and wait for the future that is uncertain?*)

No one knows when our time on earth will expire. Time is so precious that it should never be wasted; it should especially be spent in the service to God and His people.

As baptized Catholic Christians, we are "stewards of the Master"; we are "Peter" and "the Apostles" of today's generation. We have been anointed to continue the mission that Jesus began and, just like the disciples, we are empowered by the Holy Spirit to fulfill this mission.

Receiving our faith should not end within us. The Master expects us to distribute whatever has been given to us and to share it with anyone and everyone. *Much will be required of the person entrusted with much, and still more will be demanded of the person entrusted with more.*

We all are accountable of the grace and blessings that we have received. We may not all be rich in a worldly sense but all of us are rich in a spiritual sense, having been given a special gift for a special purpose. Our gifts should be nurtured and must bear good fruits. The Good News of Jesus must be shared with all.

Isaiah 55:11 tells us, "*So shall my word be that goes forth from my mouth; It shall not return to me empty, but shall do what pleases me, achieving the end for which I sent it.*"

To wait also means to serve. Being vigilant in waiting for the Lord's return doesn't mean to be quiet and do nothing. When the Master finds His servant doing as instructed, He Himself will serve the servant. "*The master will have His servants sit down at the table and the master will wait on them.*" Imagine that! Unworthy as we are, if we are obedient to God's call, we will be rewarded according to our good deeds.

May the Holy Spirit guide our path and Jesus Christ light our way to bring us closer to God, the Father. Amen.

## GOSPEL MEDITATION

### Encourage Deeper Understanding of Scripture

St. Thomas Aquinas reminds us that, "Three things are necessary for the salvation of man: to know what he ought to believe, to know what he ought to desire, and to know what he ought to do." Everyone is called to work toward their salvation, which is ultimately union with God. Those who take this call seriously must embark upon a journey inward to the deepest recesses of their soul. In the adventure and wonder of that journey, we work out the details of our union with our Beloved. We cling to what we need to believe, remain firm in what we truly desire, and are guided by what we know we have to do. 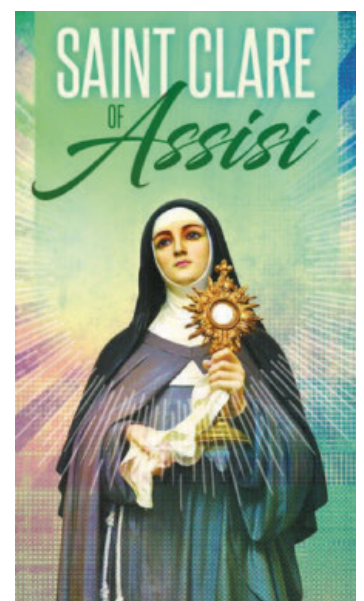

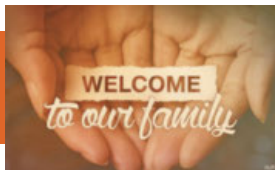

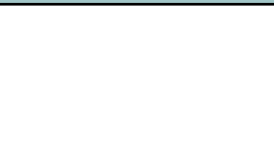
