FROM THE DESK OF FR. PETER...

Dear Holy Spirit Family,

Many of us, if not all, at some time in our lives feel, think, or say: *"If God is so Good and Loving, why does He allow all these bad or sad things to happen?"*

The Readings for our Mass this Sunday try to help us deal with our confusion, pain, and hesitation. The seven sons and their father in Maccabees give us some aid as we admire their faithfulness, courage, and sacrifice. We hope and pray that we, too, will have integrity and grace in our own lives when we are being tested or suffering.

Paul in our Second Reading is reminding us that pain and strife in our own lives, while not pleasant, often makes us better people. Think of

the many people that you know and who have suffered much and yet, they are loving and understanding, and you are glad they are part of your life. Paul, at the same time, is pointing to the suffering that JESUS bore and how we have all benefited.

Our Gospel from Luke reminds us that the way we see and understand things in this life takes on a new form in the next. The way the story of the woman and the seven husbands is presented is very logical and appears to have no solution. Jesus seems to solve the problem in a few words by pointing out that life takes on a whole new dimension in heaven.

But we are not there yet, so we go on living, often painfully, in faith, hope and love.

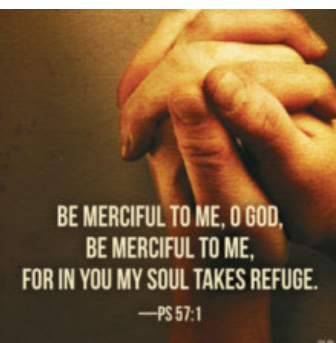

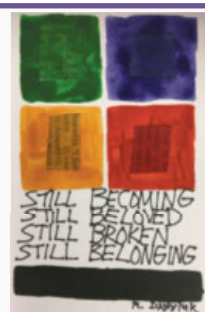
Parish Advent Mission & Retreat: "Still Becoming, Still Beloved, Still Broken, Still Belonging"
