

FROM THE DESK OF FR. EDDIE...

Beloved parishioners,

The grace of our Lenten journey is an opportunity to open our hearts to the Lord, allowing our Redeemer to enter and transform us. On this Third Sunday of Lent, we recall the encounter between Jesus and a woman of Samaria at the well. What can we make of this gospel's account of the meeting between Jesus and the Samaritan woman? Can we sense a "love story" and "a conversion moment"?

Sometimes, we experience deep frustration with ourselves and with our life. We find things in life so tough to deal with that we try to escape from them. We are fully aware that our problems and struggles are there and they're not going away, but the messiness is too overwhelming and dingy to face, so we try to cover it up. This may be true of the so many unwanted things that we store in our garages, closets, and cabinets; we try to hide them and so we become hoarders of things that we don't need and don't like to have. More seriously, it can also be true with our spiritual life that needs some cleansing and renewal for we have been holding on to our sinful ways. When we deny ourselves of God's grace of mercy, we find our lives devoid of meaning and with so much burden to bear.

"Sir, give me this water, so that I may not be thirsty..." Those were the words of the Samaritan woman when she comes face to face with a stranger in the person of our Lord.

Jesus speaks of giving living water although He has no bucket for drawing from a deep well. Yet the Lord sees the inner longings of the woman and there He invites her for personal conversion where she could find her true self and life's meaning.

Truly, we can learn from the encounter of Jesus and the Samaritan woman. What we need is a person who will help us get back to the right path towards holiness; that person is Jesus. We may be surprised to find Him already waiting for us at the wellspring of the Sacrament of Reconciliation. What can motivate us to approach the gift of mercy? It is the truth that God loves us first and He never ceases to seek for us.

I hope and pray that these forty days of Lent will guide us to find ourselves having a real experience of conversion. United with Christ, we can be renewed and there will always be hope to make amends of our sinful selves. Lent is penitential and that is the good news of the Gospel, that our Lord is here to quench our thirst for the grace to be made whole and pleasing before Him. Lent is a time to make an honest, more humble, and more sincere to return to the Lord.

"If today you hear his voice, harden not your hearts..." Let us ask for the grace to open our hearts for the call to repentance, that we may become more loving and faithful disciples of our Lord Jesus, the King of Mercy!


