

FROM THE DESK OF DN. CHUCK...

EVERYTHING IS BEAUTIFUL

In today's Gospel, Jesus rubbed clay on the blind man's eyes and sent him to bathe in the pool of

Siloam, the pool that Jewish travelers would purify themselves in before entering the Temple. It is there that this purifying ritual opened his eyes. Just as today, we use the pool of Baptism to purify ourselves and open our eyes, not to see a person's physical appearance; rather, to recognize the truth and the light of Jesus and the good in others' hearts and minds. Just as in the first reading today, the Lord tells Samuel, "Not as man sees does God see, because man sees the appearance but the Lord looks into the heart."

Everything is Beautiful is a song by Ray Stevens. And everything is beautiful. But do we see the beauty in the world around us or are we blinded by our prejudices and fears? Are we afraid of the light? Is that why we stay in the dark?

This darkness is not due to the absence of light

that comes from the sun or light bulbs; instead, it is due to the absence of the light of Christ in our lives. It is not easy to live the Gospel and walk in the light of Christ, especially today when we are subject to ridicule or damnation by those who want to remain in the dark.

Living in the light is not a matter of sight, but a matter of mind, heart and soul. As the song goes, "there are none so blind as those who will not see."


