

FROM THE DESK OF DN. BERNARD...

The internet is very much part of our day-to-day life. The majority of what we do is connected to the web. A lot

of information, whether good or bad, is stored here. To safeguard ourselves from bad sites, hackers, phishing, viruses, and other means of destroying our computer, smartphone, or other endpoint devices, we must do something to protect ourselves, otherwise, someone can steal our belongings, take hold of our personal identity or even worse, destroy our lives. The best way to shield ourselves is to filter the websites that we access. That is why we have anti-virus software and VPN that help prevent cyberthreats.

Nowadays, we are so cloud-based that we can access information and data from anywhere. As such, we have to have a Secure Web Gateway. It functions as a security solution that prevents unsecured internet traffic from entering an organization's internet network. It's used by establishments to protect employees and users from access to and from infected malicious websites and links, internet viruses, malware, and other cyberthreats and it also ensures regulatory compliance.

But despite the regulations that are implemented and the rigid controls that are in place, cybercriminals will always be security threats and will always find ways in order to enter the secured system to do harm on others.

This long, drawn-out introduction leads us to today's Gospel. Jesus Christ our Good Shepherd is

also our Good Gatekeeper. In a way, He is the Computer Administrator and the Secure Web Gateway ensuring the welfare of His people. He filters what passes through the gate by allowing only those whom He recognizes.

Jesus identifies Himself as the gate that controls and secures the entry and safety of His sheep. The flock of sheep are brought into the sheepfold each night to protect them from predators whether thieves or other wild animals.

Jesus is the gate that leads to salvation. He allows the good and faithful who hear His voice to come in and protects them from harm.

As followers of Christ, we, too, must be good shepherds and gatekeepers. We must safeguard our souls and not allow evil to enter and undermine our spiritual wellbeing by interfering with our relationship with God.

The devil will always attempt to lure us with worldly abundance to distract us and take away our focus on the Lord. Our faithfulness to God is the gateway that will protect us and allow us access to heaven. We should be vigilant in guarding ourselves from evil inclination, knowing right from wrong, and always doing what is pleasing in the sight of God. Let us always do our very best to protect our souls at all cost. For what profit do we have, if we gain the whole world but lose our own souls? (ref. Mark 8:36)

In the Sacrament of Confirmation, the baptized person is "sealed with the gift of the Holy Spirit" and is strengthened for service to the Body of Christ.


We are excited for our parish youth who will be receiving the Sacrament of Confirmation this May.
