

FROM THE DESK OF DN. CHUCK...

There Appeared to Them Tongues as of Fire Pentecost 2023

We all recognize the passage from Acts that is proclaimed every Pentecost. But did you realize that we also proclaim today's Gospel every year on this the birthday of the Church?

If we did not realize that, why not? Probably because we tend to emphasize, whether right or wrong, the Acts' proclamation. Pentecost is when the Holy Spirit descended upon the Apostles, but it also signifies that the very same Spirit has come to rest in each of us. We are the beneficiaries of the Third Person of the Trinity. He comes to rest in us so we can be in Him. The Spirit brings gifts that are freely given to us to help us in our daily lives.

Those gifts are: Fortitude, Knowledge, Counsel, Wisdom, Piety, Understanding, and Fear of the Lord (sometimes referred to as Reverence to the Lord). We each have different experiences in our lives that compel us to call upon these gifts to help persevere. The gifts are freely given with no strings attached. When we use these gifts, we stay in a state of God's grace; ignore them and we fall away.

Do not be afraid of those tongues as of fire. Embrace them and take them into your life to help you be the person that Christ intended for you to be. The Gospel proclamation? It comes from John. It is the story of Jesus coming into the locked room with the disciples and saying, "Peace be with you. As the Father as sent me, so I send you." Then he breathed on them and said, "Receive the Holy Spirit." The Gospel is the story of the Apostles receiving the Holy Spirit; Acts is the story of all creation receiving the Holy Spirit.

As Jesus sent the Apostles to do His work, we also are called to evangalize our faith in our works and in our lives. Go forth and preach the Gospel by showing others the same love that God has for you.

I would like to change things up a little bit. Instead of a Formed Pick of the Week, I would like to suggest the movie, "Courageous: Honor Begins At Home".

It is the story of how a group of men came together to put their faith into action. It is available on Prime streaming service from Amazon.

If you are an Amazon prime member, it is available to you. If not, you can find a family member or friend who is and ask them to stream it for you. Whichever works for you, watch it with others so you can share your thoughts.
