

Campus Master Plan Update 12 May 2023

With the feedback received from our parish community and our staffs, and in working with our architects, our pastor Fr Ken Sales, business manager Jeff Van der Sluis, and school principal Holly Marsh we have reimagined the original master plan. This includes modifying the existing school rather than building a new one and addressing some of the other concerns raised as well. Most importantly, we have retained the recommendations in the Programming Plan to meet the needs as identified by our community.

The next steps are to identify a cost-estimating firm to give us estimates for new construction and renovations of existing structures (based on square footage), as well as parking, play areas, etc. We will then engage a capital campaign partner to do some feasibility studies.

Once we have confidence in a plan that meets our parish needs and can be realistically achieved through fundraising efforts, then we will have another town hall meeting to present the reimagined plan.

One last note: The filing for Chapter 11 by the Diocese of Oakland may cause some delays. However, we will continue to work on our plans until the bankruptcy process works its way through, so that we will be ready to move forward without delay.
