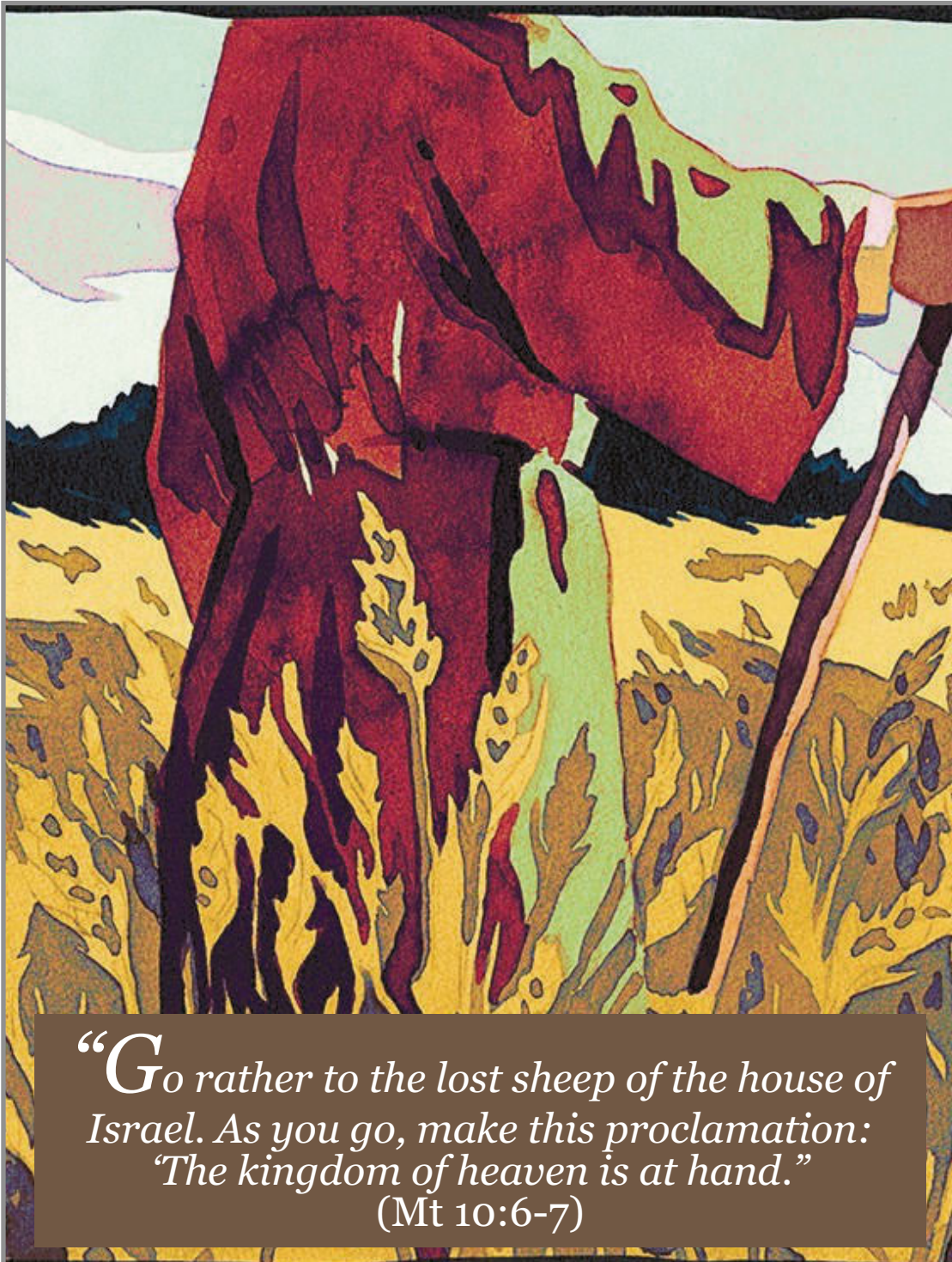

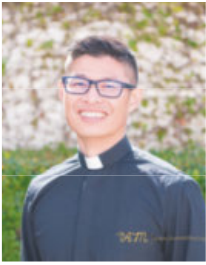

FROM THE DESK OF FR. PETER...

Dear Holy Spirit Family,

Today we celebrate Father's Day. As we turn to the scripture of the day, we find that God is our Father. Reflecting on the word "FATHER," we see it is about creating and generating new life.

Our First Reading this Sunday has God saying, "...I bore you up on eagle wings...", reminding us all how we all are loved by HIM.

Paul also reminds us how God, our Father, showed us that in Christ, He was willing to die for us. Like any good dad, God was willing to defend us and make excuses for us, because we are HIS. As Paul said: "It is through the love of Jesus Christ that we have been ALL reconciled."

In the Gospel, when Jesus saw the crowd of people around Him, the first reaction was that His heart was filled with pity for all in the crowd. Jesus immediately felt they were troubled, and they were feeling abandoned like children without parents. Then Jesus did a wonderful thing. He calls together twelve ordinary men, and He gives them the authority to drive out unclean spirits and cure every illness.

This is a lovely message for all of us today. So many of us feel so lonely and abandoned,

wondering what is going to happen to us. Today, of all Sundays, we need to see God, above all, as a loving and understanding Father.

My own father is a good man, very quiet, loving, hardworking, faithful provider and protector of his family, a man of faith. Still, as I observe many dads with their sons today, I see a kind of relationship I wish I had with my father and I might have shared, a closeness and mutual acceptance that seems to have escaped us despite the great love I know he has for me and for him.

Times have changed and parenting is different today, thank God. What Father's Day means to each of us depends so much on our relationship with our own dad and his with us.

Scripture is telling us that a true parent, like God, does not first see what is wrong with us. Instead, He intuitively recognizes our needs and is more than willing to respond to them. A good Father does not judge! He loves. He heals. He forgives.

In my time of almost three years here at Holy Spirit, I have received from you, my dear friends, much love, forgiveness, and help. I beg for your blessings, good will, and prayers for the next stage of me trying to be a good father.

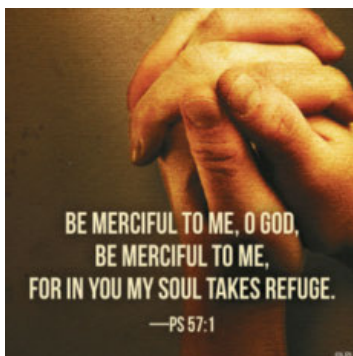

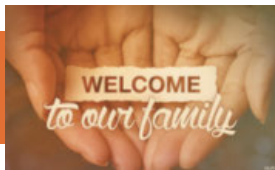
