FROM THE DESK OF SR. ANNETTE...

Who Do You Say?

Everything in Peter's life brings him to the moment in today's


Gospel when he testifies who lesus is for him. Note that he says, "You are the Christ." Originally Christ was a title, the Greek form of "messiah" meaning the "anointed One." Over the year, the "the" was dropped so it appears in St Paul's letters as Jesus Christ, but Christ is not his last name. "However. Christ is more than lesus. Christ, the Word incarnate, is the one in whom all created reality is transformed in the personal love of God." (Ilia Delio) Peter's many experiences – the large catch of fish, calming of the sea, walking on water, his bewilderment, and his fidelity to Jesus in saying, "...to whom shall we go? You have the words of everlasting life." (In 6:68) – lead him to this moment when he can say "You are the Christ."

The angel Gabriel told Mary that her son Jesus will be the Son of God (Lk 1:31). We have the testimony of God the Father twice in the gospels when God announces "This is my beloved Son" at the baptism of Jesus (Mt 3:17, Mk 1:11, Luke 3:22 & Jn 1:34) and again at His transfiguration (Mt 17:5, Mk 9:7, Lk 9:35 & 2 Pet 1:17). Even the demons recognized Jesus as the Son of God (Mk 5:7). Others also recognized Jesus as the Son of God or Messiah: the Samaritan Woman (Jn 4:29), Martha (Jn 11:27), and the Centurion at his death (Mk 15:39). Nevertheless, Jesus always referred to Himself as the "Son of Man" and modeled for us how to live as a child of God.

We owe a debt of gratitude to St. Matthew who showed how Jesus fulfilled the various prophecies in the Hebrew Scriptures. Another debt of gratitude goes to St. Paul who, through his letters, began the development of Christology, the study of Christ, which is still being carried forward with theologians of today. I am deeply moved by the thought that Christ is the "firstborn of all creation" (Col 1:15) and that Christ is the end "goal of creation" or in Teilhard de Chardin's view of Christ as the "Omega point." All of this is summarized in our great Eucharistic prayer when the priest and deacon hold the Body and Blood of Christ up for all of us to see and says, "Through Him, with Him and in Him." We acknowledge and agree with our heartfelt "Amen."

So today it is our turn. We are invited to answer the question: "Who do you say that I am?" My answer is: "You are the cosmic Christ, my Love, my Life, my All." What is your answer? How do you respond when Jesus asks you personally, "Who do you say that I am?"

He said to them, "But who do you say that I am?" Simon Peter said in reply, "You are the Messiah, the Son of the living God." (Mt 16:15-16)

Memorial Mass for Rev. Mr. William "Bill' Drobick † September 22, 2023, 11:00 am Holy Spirit Fremont

Please join us for Mass in memory of Dn. Bill Drobick † (1948-2023).

Dn. Bill was born and raised in Chicago, Illinois. He married Joanne "Joni" Reberg on October 24, 1971, and moved to California soon after. He is survived by wife Joni, daughter Holly Marsh, sons Matthew and Joseph Drobick, their spouses, and 11 grandchildren.

Dn. Bill serve in the Army for two years during the Vietnam War and was based at the Oakland Army Base. He later earned Masters degrees from Golden Gate University in San Francisco and the Graduate Theological Union in Berkeley.

Dn. Bill was ordained to the Permanent Diaconate (along with fellow Holy Spirit parishioner Dn. Richard Yee) in February 1995 by Bishop Emeritus John Cummins. He was assigned to Holy Spirit Parish following his ordination under the pastorship of Rev. Gerard Moran and later Rev. Mathew Vellankal[†]. Along with various ministries, he served as Director of Religious Education and Confirmation.

After his retirement as D.R.E. of Holy Spirit, Dn. Bill went on to serve at St. Agnes Parish in Concord, CA, under Rev. Johnson Abraham.

Dn. Bill and Joni relocated to Florence, AZ, where they joined and served



at Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary Catholic Church. Dn. Bill was involved in prison ministry, which included visits with death row inmates and youth in Juvenile Hall.


