

FROM THE DESK OF FR. BINH...

Are you ready to be joyful for Christmas?

If a child needs a reason to state why he loves Christmas most, he will probably say it is because he receives presents from Santa Claus. Adults love Christmas, too, but for different reasons. Perhaps they enjoy colorful decorations or cold weather.

There are many other reasons for a person to like Christmas. For Christians, the favorite thing about Christmas should be because Jesus was born for the world. When Jesus is among us, and we have Him, we can rejoice anytime. He is a great joy. Because of Jesus, we can delight in all seasons and circumstances. Rejoice always through Him, with Him, and in Him.

Today is Rose Sunday. This year, Christmas Eve will occur on the same evening as the Fourth Sunday of Advent. Christmas is around the corner, and you can now whisper the lyric, "It's beginning to look a lot like Christmas."

Remember your joy on Christmas! If anyone asks how you can be so joyful all the time, you can reply with one of the following quotes from today's readings:

"I rejoice heartily in the LORD, in my God is the joy of my soul;" (Isaiah)

"My spirit rejoices in God my Savior, for he has looked upon his lowly servant." (Luke)

"In all circumstances give thanks, for this is the will of God for you in Christ Jesus." (1 Thessalonians)

I invite you to rejoice and be optimistic, not because I encourage you to ignore your reality. You may have a beautiful life or be in a struggling exile. God knows you well, and the words of God this weekend remind us that we have Jesus in our lives. We need to remember his presence.

On November 15, 2013, during his Wednesday General Audience, Pope Francis stressed that Jesus is our joy, "Each of us, today take a little time and think: 'Jesus, You are within me: I want to meet You every day. You are a Person, not an idea; You are a companion, not a program. You are Love that solves so many problems. You are the beginning of evangelization. You, Jesus, are the source of joy.'


We must be joyful for others because Jesus is the source of joy, and we want to be like Him. Jesus brings the world joy, we are called to do the same. Whoever you are and whatever you face, "rejoice always," as Saint Paul suggests.

Father Elipenda's Advent Message (excerpt):

Fr. Elipenda explains that the Advent period has two elements; we are reminded of when the Son of God "came to us the first time, and immediately prepares us to receive him when he comes to us again on the last day."

Fr. Elipenda goes on to say: "As he fulfilled the promise the first time, he will also fulfill it the second time, although to him a thousand years are like one day. Between the two advents, the Lord comes to us continuously in the sacraments (especially the Eucharist) and in daily life through events and people (especially the poor). So we should always be ready to receive him so that on the last day we will meet him, and he will welcome us to eternal life. We should also ask him to come to deliver us, he who is our hope.

May the God's blessing be upon you all. Amen."




