# **NOURISH**



FROM THE DESK OF SR. KAREN...

Our first reading this weekend is from the Book of Job. As we recall the story, Job was faithful to God

and was blessed with many children and many animals, but Satan told God that Job was only faithful because God had given him so much. The Book of Job was to help the Hebrew people see that God is with us in good times and in bad, and that good and evil happen to everyone.

God allowed Satan to cause bad things to happen and Job was in deep despair. His friends shared the beliefs of the day that he must have sinned to bring this on himself. Job spoke of accepting good and evil from God and stayed faithful. Job knew he had not done anything wrong and kept pleading for God's help. God eventually did respond, encouraging Job and condemning his friends' treatment of Job.

Our lives have times of bad luck as well as times filled with blessings. In times of deep despair, we might turn to the Book of Job and be reminded that God's heart goes out to the afflicted when we call. Job shared his feelings with his friends, but they did not console him; instead, they criticized and blamed him. When someone opens their heart to you, how do you respond? If we listen with the Spirit's presence, we would be able to be a compassionate presence for others. As a pastoral minister to the sick, that is what we do. And in a sense, that is what we are all called to do when someone pours out their feelings. When a person sharing heavy feelings experiences God's love, the weight of suffering seems to be shared and lightened. It's like medicine for the soul that allows God's healing to enter.

Have you ever experienced the Spirit's presence in you, that becomes real for others? The tragic experiences Job suffered seemed to be over rather quickly, but the pain afterwards lingered on. We are reminded in Psalm 147 that "the Lord heals the brokenhearted". When we go through the valley of the shadow of death it is so helpful to have family and friends we can talk with who can help us deal with all the questions we are struggling with, but not all have the compassionate skill to listen with God's heart. If you find yourself going through rough times a spiritual mentor may be helpful.


# St. Joseph the Worker: Sister Parish Dispatch


