

The Loop of Grace

The first reading of today's Scripture reminds me of Bishop

Barron's "loop of grace" in his book, This Is My Body, that we received as a Christmas gift from the parish. He describes the "loop of grace" as "what you have received as a gift, give as a qift." Robert Barron, This Is My Body, 16 Abraham received Isaac as God's gift, and yet the Lord instructed Abraham to sacrifice his son. Because he did not withhold Isaac from God. Isaac's life was spared. God's promise of many descendants was then fulfilled through Isaac because of Abraham's obedience. St. Paul tells us, "God did not spare his own Son but handed him over for us all." So, "if God is for us, who can be against us?" "How will he not also give us everything else along with him?" Romans 8:31-32 God's gift of life pulses through our veins. God teaches us in every breath that we cannot hold on to it, but must surrender it, give it back to God in order to inhale again. A gift received that is given back, as a gift of gratitude. Inhaling we receive "yes", and exhaling we give "thanks." This "loop of grace" is a constant in our lives.

The gospel shares a moment in the life of Jesus and the apostles when they were "caught up." Peter, James, and John are caught up by the vision of a transfigured Jesus, dazzling white,

talking with Moses and Elijah on a mountain top. A sight so overwhelming, they are stopped in their tracks. Peter wants to hold on to the vision by setting up three tents. "Then a cloud came, casting a shadow over them; from the cloud came a voice, 'This is my beloved Son. Listen to him.' Suddenly looking around, they no longer saw anyone, but Jesus alone with them." Mark 9:7-8

There are times in our lives when we are stopped in our tracks or catch our breath. Have you ever been "caught up" by a thought, a work of art, the vastness of the sky at night, the beauty of a flower? "Transformation occurs each time we open our hearts to another or notice the incredible beauty in a sunrise or a small child's smile." Mary Ellen Higgins, IHM I like to think of these moments as God moments. "The presence of God exudes a joy, peace, strength, tranguility beyond human explanations. We are transformed" Carroll Sthulmueller, CP Like Peter, lames, and John, we must come down from the mountain, but the experience needs to have changed us, stays with us, informs us, and influences our lives. This is what spiritual direction or spiritual companioning is all about: recognizing the gifts God gives us, reflecting on the God moments in our lives, accepting the gifts that are given us, and sharing them with others are all part of the "loop of grace."

May you grow in awareness of the loops of grace each day! May you share freely the gifts you receive! May "God moments" transform your life!

This is my beloved Son. Listen to him." (Mk 9:7)


