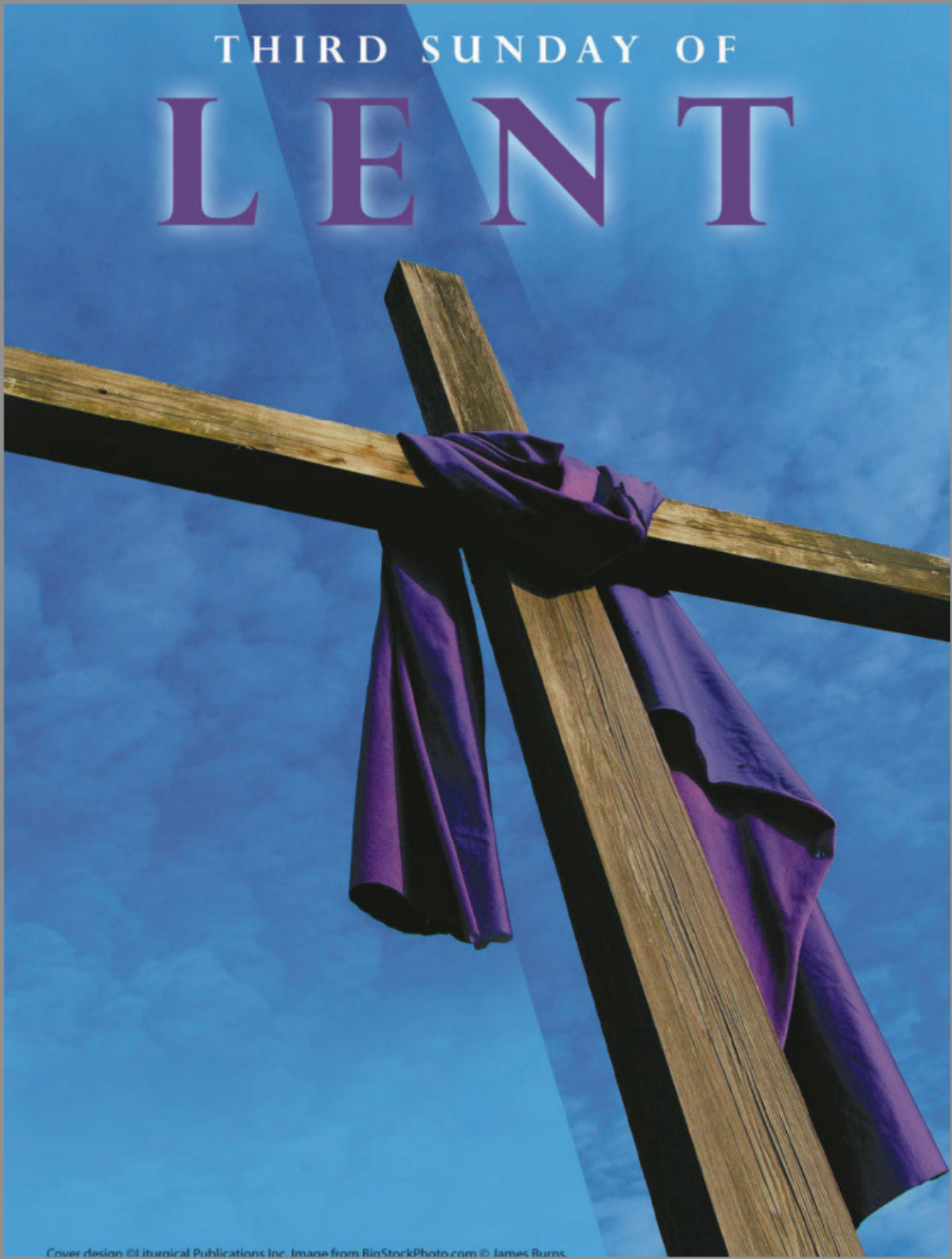

## FROM THE DESK OF DN. BERNARD...

A well is something that is deep, dark, cold, and sometimes could be empty. Just like in life, we may experience darkness, emptiness, and even depression. Living on the edge makes life dangerous, making it easier to fall into this empty state. When we live our life in these circumstances, we are very much like the Samaritan woman at the well.

Having had different husbands and currently living with the person she is unmarried to makes the Samaritan woman unwanted, sinful, and despised by many, including the Jewish people. Jesus comes into the picture and, despite all odds, turns things around for her: first, that a Jew would speak to a Samaritan; second, that a man would speak to a woman he didn't know in public; and third, that a Jew would drink from a Samaritan's utensil.

Jesus breaks barriers in order for us to be able to come to Him, barriers of religion, gender, racism, and morality. The woman wasn't looking for Jesus. All she wanted was water. On the contrary, it was Jesus who wanted to meet her and to offer her the living water (salvation), so that she may never thirst again. The Samaritan woman had totally disobeyed God regarding marriage and morality. Jesus leads the Samaritan woman leads her to see her need, reveals who He is, and offers her something that could change her life.

Just like the Samaritan woman, when we sin, we become separated from God. We cannot be reconciled to God without repenting our sins, because sin has no place in God's goodness. However, God never stops to seek us. He wants us to come back and be constantly connected to Him. By her own admittance regarding her husband, the Samaritan woman showed her honesty and her truthfulness. When we realize we have sinned and confessed it to the priest, we become true to ourselves and to God. We show our vulnerability and dependence on Him.

When the truth dawns on this woman, she professes, "I know that the Messiah is coming, the one called the Anointed; when he comes, He will tell us everything." As soon as she heard Jesus say, "I am He, the one who speak with you," the woman leaves her water jar but instead, brings with her the living water and shares it with the town people.

May we be like the Samaritan woman; despite our sinfulness, let us allow ourselves to open up, surrender everything, and let Jesus enter into our lives. May we always repent for our sinful ways and reconcile with the Lord, and may we be filled to the brim with the life-giving water. May our lives always be filled with God's overflowing love.

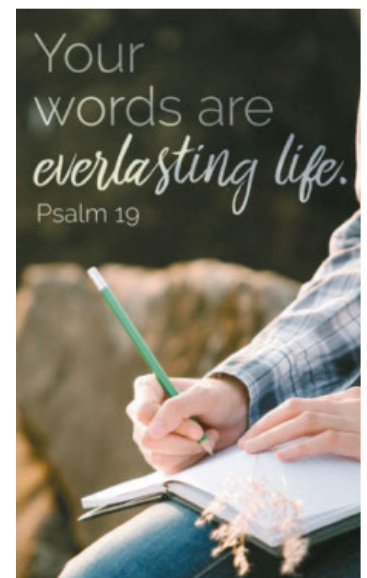

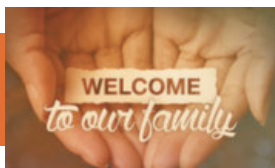
