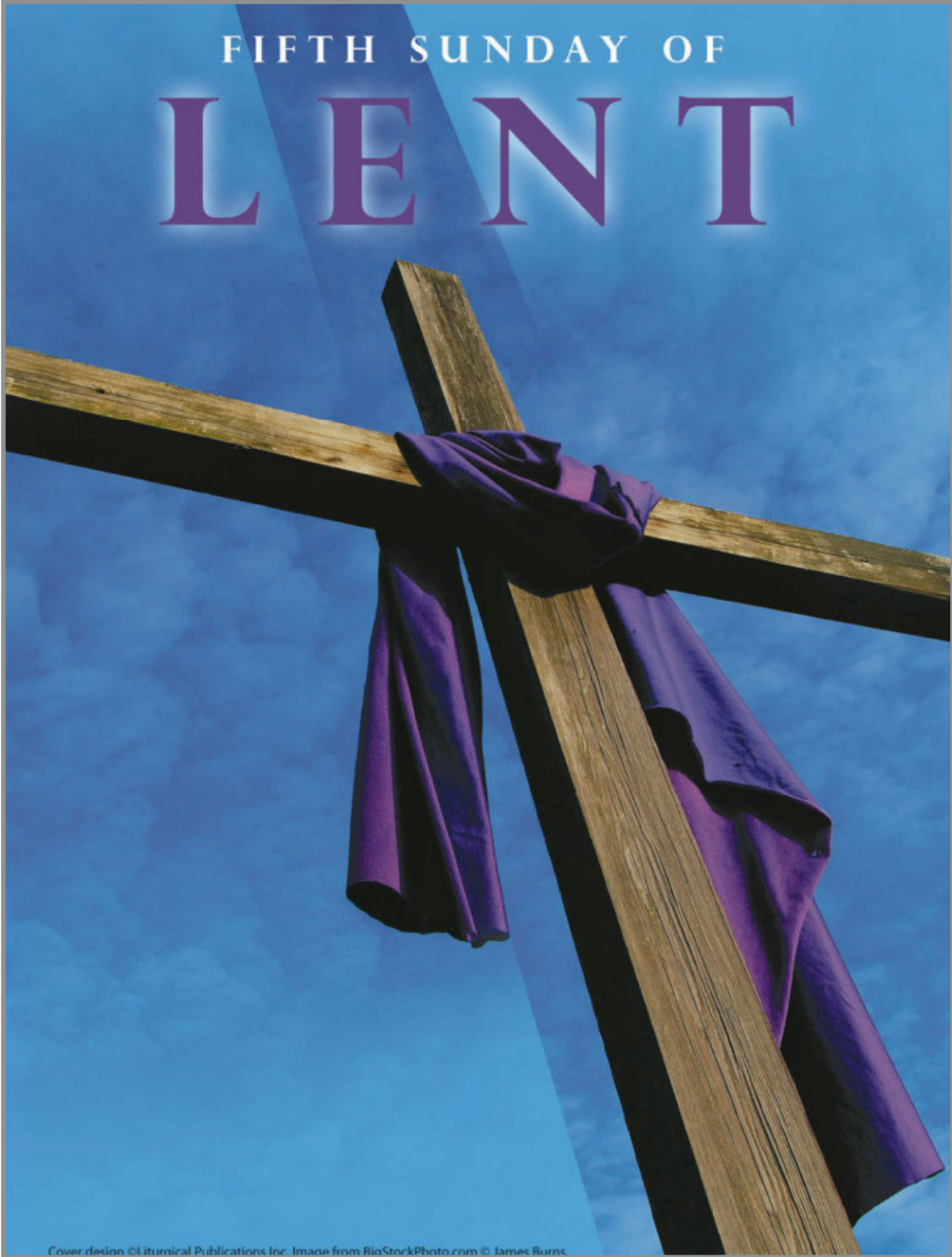

FROM THE DESK OF ROSALYN...

In today's gospel we encounter Martha and Mary mourning the loss of their beloved brother. The sisters are familiar to us, having first been introduced in the gospel of Luke (10:38-42). Martha, the perfect hostess, opens their home to their guests, while Mary finds herself a spot at the feet of the Divine Master. We meet this family again when Mary spares no expense in honoring their guest (Jn 12:1-8). As I reflect on the friendship of the sisters with our Lord, it is reminiscent of the many seasons of our own faith.

The many times we have, like Mary, set out on an earnest path of discipleship. Immersing ourselves in prayers, devotions, and attending talks and events to grow in our faith. At other times, when as caring host (such as parent or caregiver), we allow ourselves to be drawn into the events around us, life situations that demand all our time and attention, leaving us with little or no time for Jesus. Hopefully, that is a short season.

Notice how the roles are reversed in today's Gospel; on hearing that Jesus was coming, Mary stayed home. It was Martha who ran to Jesus. Was Mary upset with Jesus, disappointed that the Messiah had allowed sorrow to enter her life and left her to face a life without her

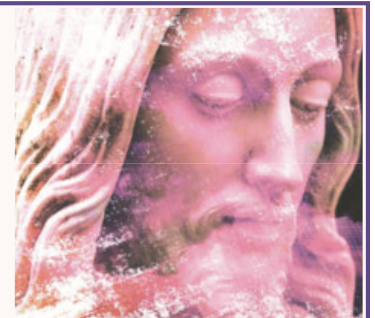
beloved brother? How about when we lose a loved one, are faced with a terrifying medical diagnosis or unexpected challenges and our dreams come crashing down? I can honestly say that I plead guilty to being upset sometimes with our Lord.

Even in the difficult times in our life, we wholeheartedly cling to our faith in our Lord, albeit without a full understanding of His love. We unreservedly surrender our lives to Him in the face of extreme challenges, like Martha who, even though her brother had been dead for four days, declares, "even now I know that whatever you ask of God, God will give you."

We proclaim our deep love for our Lord when we give of ourselves, our time, treasure, and talent in humble worship, like Mary who anointed His feet with expensive perfume (John 12:1-8).

Even though Mary might have been displeased with Jesus, later, when she learns privately that Jesus is calling for her, she goes quickly to Jesus, falls at His feet (Jn 11:28-32), and shares her sorrow with Him. In our struggles we too can offer up our pain and challenges to God so that just as in the Gospel, it may be used "that the Son of God may be glorified through it." Though we do not fully understand many of our trials, we know that Jesus loves us, weeps with us, and will raise us up. "For nothing will be impossible with God." (Luke 1:37).

“I am the resurrection and the life; whoever believes in me, even if he dies, will live, and everyone who lives and believes in me will never die.” (Jn 11:25-26)

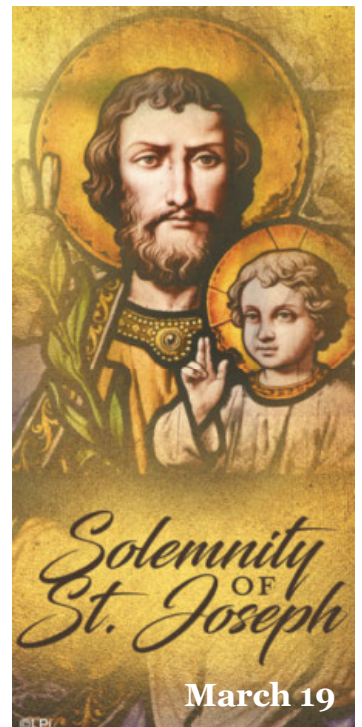
