

## Maintenance & Improvement Fund

Q: What Is It?

A: The Maintenance & Improvement Fund (M&I) will be a second collection on the first weekend of each month. Restricted funds collected will be used for the maintenance and improvement of our facilities and deferred maintenance.

Q: What are some examples of how the funds could be used?

A: The M&I Fund can be used for repairs such as plumbing issues, broken sprinklers, roof leaks, a new roof, water heaters that go out, campus lighting, and improved security. See a recent example below. Fr. Frank had a leak in his rectory bathroom, when we pulled up the floor, below is what we found. All the sheet rock, flooring and the shower was replaced and repaired. The M&I Fund would support unexpected repairs like Fr. Frank's bathroom.

Q: Why should I support the Maintenance & Improvement Fund?

A: Please keep in mind that supporting this fund should be above and beyond what you already tithe to our regular plate collection. It shouldn't take the place of your overall support to the parish through our regular plate collection. This fund will provide the needed financial reserves to handle emergency repairs, deferred maintenance projects (i.e. Governo House Roof), parking lot resurfacing and repairs and maintaining the much needed technology and equipment to livestream our Masses and other Parish events. These funds will only be used for the maintenance and improvement of our facilities.
