

FROM THE DESK OF SR. KAREN...

Ignatian Spirituality encourages the use of our imagination in prayer. One of my favorite ways of doing that is to pretend I am


one of the people in the Gospel story and allow an experience to play out as my imagination allows.

In this Gospel, I picture being one of the women who followed Jesus and were with the Apostles in that room with the doors locked, huddled together for fear of being found by the temple guard or soldiers. In the early morning Mary Magdalene and some of the other women went to the tomb and found it empty; they informed the Apostles of the tale, and everyone was still in disbelief, except a few of us. Mary Magdalene saw Him, but we were all in a state of shock. Jesus had told the Apostles several times that all this would happen; that He would be arrested, scourged, crucified, died, and that He would rise. No one really believed all that, but here we are now after the fact.

In my imagination I am not quite sure what to do. Fix food, pack up my belongings and go back home, what? Then suddenly Jesus is standing in the room looking alive and radiant! It is true but I still can't take it in and am fearful it is just a figment of my imagination until He speaks to us, "Peace". As always, when Jesus would say "Shalom", it happens for real! Everyone in the room felt peace come over us and I wanted to embrace Him and sing, dance, and shout Alleluia! My favorite word!

What does this all mean? More questions flood my mind and heart. We all gathered around Him, and He showed us the marks of the crucifixion on His hands and side but also His head where the crown of thorns had been placed. Then after seeing His body, He reassured us by saying, "Peace" (Shalom) and again that word became true for all of us. Then He breathed on all of us. His breath was so powerful and sweet, filled with the strength and courage of the Holy Spirit to be able to forgive others and to be willing to ask for forgiveness, too, to go forth and share the good news with everyone.

Even Thomas had his faith restored by seeing and touching Jesus' wounds. Again, we all received Shalom from God through His Son standing in our midst. What a wonderful Easter gift!


