FROM THE DESK OF SR. ANNETTE...

This day known as Good Shepherd Sunday is also Vocation Sunday. In the Gospel, Jesus declares, "I am the good shepherd, and I know mine and mine know me" (John 10:14). Jesus

describes how a shepherd cares for the sheep. They know his voice and follow him wherever he goes. This World Day of Prayer for Vocations is designated for all walks of life.

During the Easter Season we celebrate our newly baptized and remember our own baptism. "See what love the Father has bestowed on us ... we are God's children now; what we shall be has not yet been revealed" (1 John 3:1-2). I am sure you were asked as a child or may have asked your own children, "What do you want to be when you grow up?" Responses like, "fireman," "teacher," or "president of the US" always cause us to smile. These careers or vocations cause me to wonder if maybe we get the question wrong. Should that question really be: "What do you want to do with your gifts and talents?"

In the book of Genesis, God says, "Let us make human beings in our image, after our likeness." I believe that while we are all made in God's image, it is our task to become like God. Looking at the world around us, I see there are three ways of "being" in God's image (our personal vocation) in this world: single, married, or communal. Where is the pull? How are we called? Where is our total gift of self: a career, a life partner/ family, or service as a priest or religious?

Being and doing are two different things. How does God's life and love flow through us? What is our basic

stance of being? How can we best be like God or imitate God? We know that most people choose a marriage partner and dedicate their lives to raising their families. Others may choose to remain single because their gift of self in their profession is so consuming. And others offer their gift of self in a broader communal context such as priesthood or religious life.


"God calls whomever he wills through a free initiative of his love. But [God] wants to call through other persons. ... It was Andrew who called his brother Peter ... Philip called Nathaniel. We should not be afraid to directly suggest to a young or not so young person that the Lord may be calling them. ... It can be a moment of light and grace." (Pope John Paul II, Rome, Italy, April 13, 1983)

So, parents and grandparents take this opportunity to help your children and grandchildren grow in understanding the graces and talents that God has given them. Some graces are so innate that we do not recognize the gift received until someone points it out for us. When you notice a good or natural quality, point it out -- you would make a good Dad or priest because ... or a good mother or sister because Help them realize that their unique calling as being in this world and their profession or career as a vocation, a way of doing. Remember that priests and religious have many of the same careers: doctors, lawyers, nurses, teachers, social workers, farmers, bakers, etc.

May you be blessed growing in the image of the Father -- as a parent creating and sustaining your family; or as an image of Jesus in the total gift of self to your mission; or in the image of the Holy Spirit going wherever sent, sanctifying and building the Kingdom of God.

"I am the good shepherd, and I know mine and mine know me, just as the Father knows me and I know the Father; and I will lay down my life for the sheep."

(Jn 10:14-15)
