

## FROM THE DESK OF FR. EDDIE...

Beloved parishioners,

"Lord, send out your Spirit, and renew the face of the earth." As we celebrate the Feast of Pentecost, let us pray for each other that we will be receptive to the renewing and strengthening power of the Holy Spirit. This feast also marks the 138th Anniversary of Holy Spirit Church since its founding. This year, we gather once again with joy and gratitude in our parish festival with the theme, "God's Family United in Faith, Mission and Service," to which we, as God's family of diverse communities, are called to grow in fidelity to all that the gospel demands of us especially during these challenging and turbulent times.

The outpouring of the Holy Spirit like tongues of fire begins the birth and universality of the Church. Since that day, from the Upper Room through all the corners of the world, the Holy Spirit as our Advocate has been the force that guides and inspires the Church forever. Filled with the Holy Spirit, the apostles, along with Mary, began to preach courageously. Strengthened by the Holy Spirit, those frightened men were transformed into courageous preachers who feared neither prison, persecution, nor death, and the Holy Spirit continues His work to this day.

As Christians, we must be clear that the Holy Spirit, the Third Person of the Holy Trinity, is our Sanctifier and Advocate, the one that will guide our being to the truth. When we remember that at the heart of our faith there lies the conviction that "No one can say, 'Jesus is Lord' except by the Holy Spirit," then we should allow ourselves to be empowered by the Spirit. Saint Paul also mentioned, "If we live in the Spirit, let us also follow the Spirit," and so we go in

peace and in joy to where we are prompted to go to become witnesses and missionaries of our faith.

I do hope we will all become involved in the life of our parish. The question we are all being asked to consider and discuss is this: What do you think God is asking of us at this time? It may seem to be a simple question; however, a little pondering might lead us to see how profound this question is. It is not inviting us simply to offer what we would like to donate to the parish, to come to Sunday masses, or the usual things we do. Instead, it is an urgent call for us to reclaim our missionary identity and calling as God's family. This call necessitates a great amount of courage and humility and trusting faith for us to acknowledge that it is by the Holy Spirit who guides the Church that we can fulfill the missionary task and responsibility in greater fidelity to God's given identity and mission.

I am hoping that every family, together with the parish, will animate the involvement of each member of the household in our parish life. The future of Holy Spirit Church is not in our hands; it is in God's hands. Yet God works in and through His people, and this implies that God works in and through all of us who together make up the Church, the Body of Christ. Therefore, please make time to be with the rest of the parishioners in celebrating our parish festival. Please share your own experience of the parish in your lives, and your hopes and dreams for Holy Spirit Church.

Happy Feast of Pentecost to all of you! Happy Anniversary Holy Spirit Church! I have you all in my prayers.



## Gospel Meditation Encourage Deeper Understanding of Scripture

When I was twenty-two years of age in August of 2000, I experienced World Youth Day in Rome. As for many of my generation, the event was life-changing for me. Surrounded by joyful, hope-filled young people from seemingly every nation and tongue, we were gathered around the Pope, sharing a common Faith and love. The Pope spoke to us of our shared family bond in the Church and invited us to give our lives in service to others. Now twenty-four years later, my life as a priest, like that of so many others from those special days, continues on that same path of love and unity — despite my many weaknesses. What makes that continuation possible?

This week's feast gives the answer: the Holy Spirit. The gift of God — His very life — the third person of the Trinity, is the Spirit who animates the entire Church and each member of it. He makes us one-in-love in a way that utterly exceeds human capacity. For example, he makes the apostles speak with tongues of fire, and everyone hears them in his own native tongue. The Holy Spirit is the means by which Jesus establishes a new family, one that crosses all possible boundaries of time, space, and culture. The Holy Spirit never tires in enthusing us for mission.

Aren't we longing to experience the Holy Spirit in a fresh way? Today we celebrate this untiring flame, once ignited on earth and burning still. So, we humbly cry out: Come, Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of your faithful, and enkindle in us the fire of your love!




