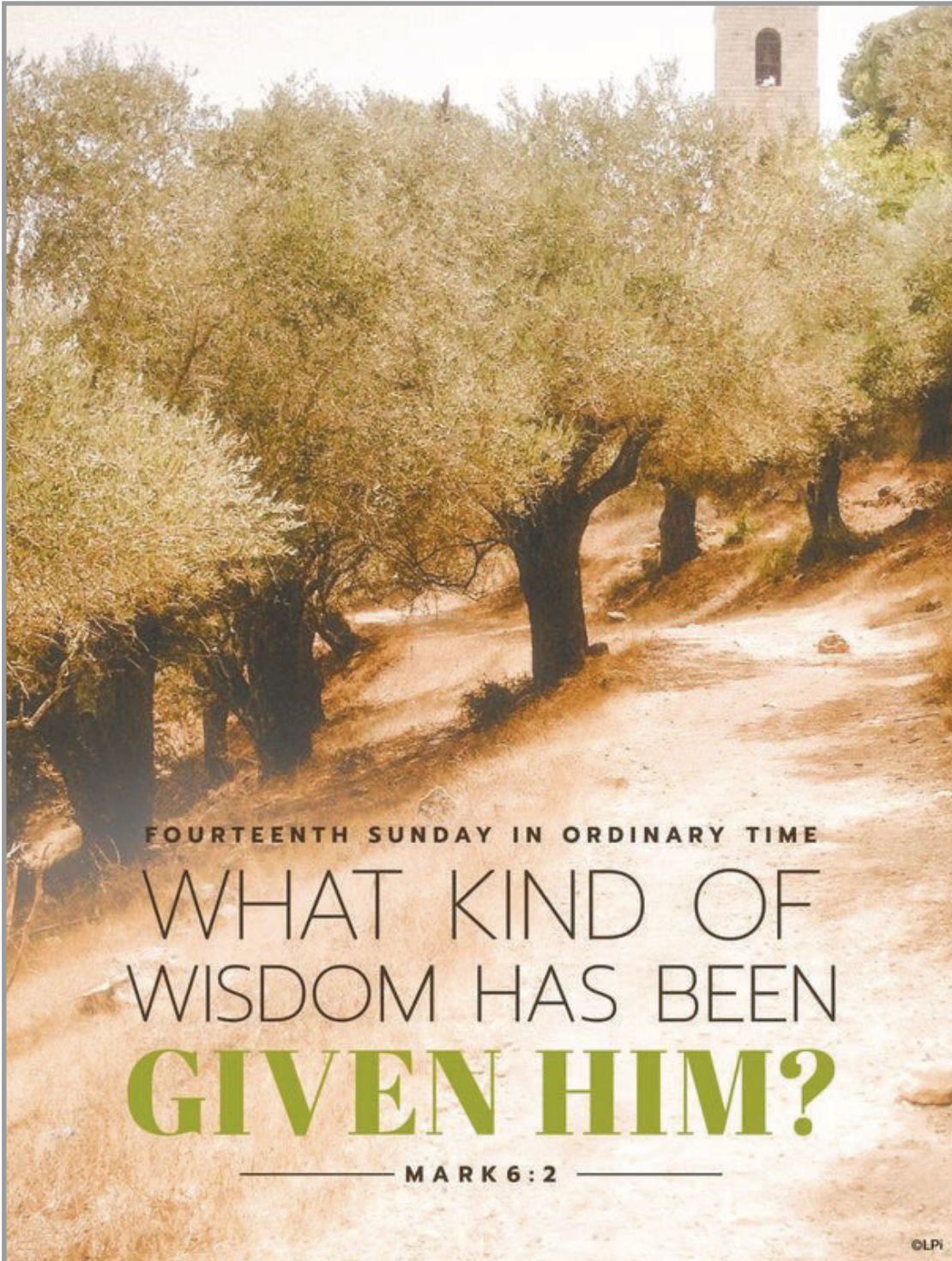

FROM THE DESK OF ROSALYN...

The gospel today narrates an incident in Nazareth. The townsfolk fail to recognize the prophet among them.

The Israelites had been waiting for centuries for the Messiah - a prophet like Moses, or a king – to lead and liberate them, restore the kingdom to its former glory, and free them from oppression. The Psalms they recited everyday pointed to a messiah who would be both King and Priest. It is no wonder that they failed to recognize the lowly carpenter. One who would not wage war but turn the other cheek. One with a message of love, forgiveness, and humble service. Jesus did not fit the bill.

Jesus was truly man while remaining truly God (CCC 464). But the townsfolk He grew up with were only familiar with His humanity. They had heard reports of all the wondrous things that He had done in other places. Though they were astonished at His wisdom and His mighty deeds, this familiarity prevented them from seeing His divinity. They could not see beyond what they knew about Jesus. They had closed their hearts to Jesus.

Fast forward to the years after Jesus' resurrection. The apostles spread the gospel throughout the world, and many were martyred. What made them give up home and family to travel to distant foreign lands and be willing to die for Christ when

his own townsmen would not accept him? The difference, I believe, is the personal relationship that the apostles had with Christ.

We can be like the Nazoreans, too; we are familiar with Jesus but do not wholeheartedly have faith in him. Many of us have been raised memorizing and reciting prayers, hearing scripture stories, celebrating feasts, and going to mass, yet we neither have a personal relationship with Jesus nor claim Him as our own Lord and Savior. Instead, we are merely going through the motions every Sunday, so to speak, rather than having a deep conviction at the core of our being. It is the difference between knowing someone and knowing about someone. When one knows someone, they enjoy spending time together and being with them (think of our closest friends, family). Knowing about someone is hearing or reading about a person without actually having any contact or communication with them.

There are also times when we, like the Nazoreans, harden our hearts, so sure of ourselves and our ability to find happiness, peace, and success. We fail to see the many ways God is working in our lives. When we are too wrapped up in the pursuit of the things we think will fulfill us, we become distant from God. To be able to hear the prompting of the Holy Spirit and to receive His grace, we must have a certain softness of heart.

Our Lord invites us daily to a deeper relationship with Him, to a greater surrender and faith. Let us pray for the grace to open our hearts to know Him more.

Jesus said to them, “A prophet is not without honor except in his native place and among his own kin and in his own house.”

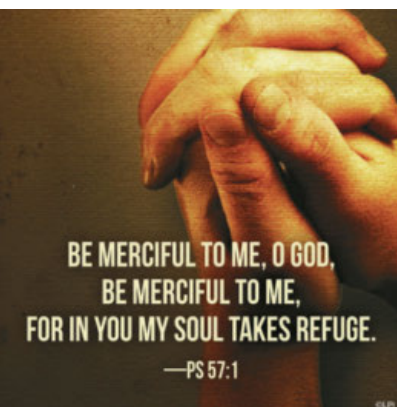
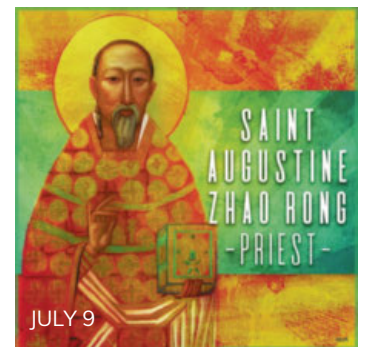

Return to Distribution of the Precious Blood at Holy Communion

Beginning the weekend of August 3-4, 2024, we will once again offer Holy Communion under both species (bread and wine) here at Holy Spirit Parish.

Bishop Michael C. Barber, SJ, released a statement in May 2023 allowing the distribution of the Precious Blood, at the discretion of each pastor. The decision to reintroduce the offering of the chalice post-pandemic here at Holy Spirit has not been made lightly, and we are buoyed by the fact that, according to the CDC, we have "...more tools and resources than ever before to better protect ourselves and our communities."

Each of us should make our own decision when it comes to receiving one or both species. If you are immunocompromised, have respiratory symptoms, or may have been exposed to COVID or flu, it may be best to receive only the host.

We will begin by offering four chalices at each Vigil/Sunday Mass. Please be patient should we run out of the Precious Blood before you come to receive. We will adjust the amount of wine that is consecrated at each Mass as we gain experience with the number of people who seek to receive it.

Please note: One does not need to receive Holy Communion under both species to receive the full grace of the sacrament. The Catechism of the Catholic Church states: "Since Christ is sacramentally present under each of the species, communion under the species of bread alone makes it possible to receive all the fruit of Eucharistic grace." (CCC, No. 1390)

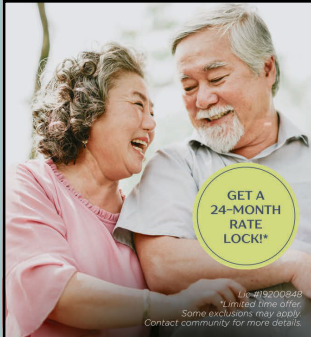

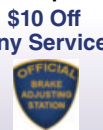
