

Let's Get Away From It All

It's another hot summer day. The morning has started like all

summer days. You want to do your daily chores before it gets too hot. But with the children home from school, they also have needs. You finally make it through the morning. But then it's time to prepare lunch. No matter what you prepare, someone isn't happy with the choice. About 2pm, the littlest ones are down for a nap and the older ones are quietly playing in their rooms. Taking this as a sign, you grab your book for a few moments of peace and quiet. You prop your feet up on the footstool and get settled in. The next sound you hear is, "MOMMY" or "DADDY".

You know you need time to rest and recuperate but those around you don't always recognize that. Jesus understood that very same thing. He tells the Apostles to come away to rest. They load up in the boat and head for a deserted place, but they notice a crowd of people following their progress.

Jesus knows the Apostles need rest. He takes on the crowds by Himself and allows the Apostles to have some "me" time. He protects them. They rest and decompress. They take the time to just relax. Soon, they will face trials and tribulations, and they will need all the stamina and energy they can gather.

We don't all decompress in the same way. There is a comic strip called "Rose is Rose". When life starts getting to her, Rose Gumbo goes to her "let things be" tree. She leans against the tree and just lets things be. When Rose's husband, Jimbo, takes the garbage out, he takes the time to enjoy the night and the stars. It is important to have these spots, the "let things be" tree or the nightly garbage can contemplation. Whatever works for you. Because no matter how we decompress, there is one thing we all have in common. We need rest to be able to fulfill our life vocations to the best of our ability.

The Apostles relied on Jesus to give them the chance to rest. To make the most of our own down time, we also need to rely on Him. Just as He protected the Apostles' rest time, having Him with us will protect our rest and recovery.

By taking the time to rest and recharge with Jesus, by making Him the center of your life, He will create within you the ability to tackle life and do what needs to be done. Because after all, there is always more to be done.

Mission Cooperative Plan: Order of St. John Paul II July 20-21, 2024

This weekend's Special Collection benefits the Order of St. John Paul II, on behalf of the Kenema Diocese in Sierra Leone, Africa, one of the poorest dioceses in the Catholic Church.

The Kenema Diocese has 22 priests and serves 90,000 Catholics in 19 parishes. The diocese operates 230 primary schools and 20 secondary schools, most of which, along with many of the



parishes, need major repairs.

The Kenema Diocese is not selfsufficient. At the height of the COVID pandemic, the national government closed all churches and public gatherings,



eliminating collection support for the priests and parishes. Until the Sierra Leone government lifted restrictions, there were no funds to pay priests.

We will be joined by Dr. Terry Rees at all the Masses. Dr. Rees is the founder, Superior General and Executive Director of the Order of St. John Paul II.



Return to Distribution of the Precious Blood at Holy Communion

Beginning the weekend of August 3-4, 2024, we will once again offer Holy Communion under both species (bread and wine) here at Holy Spirit Parish.

Bishop Michael C. Barber, SJ, released a statement in May 2023 allowing the distribution of the Precious Blood, at the discretion of each pastor. The decision to reintroduce the offering of the chalice post-pandemic here at Holy Spirit has not been made lightly, and we are buoyed by the fact that, according to the CDC, we have "...more tools and resources than ever before to better protect ourselves and our communities."

Each of us should make our own decision when it comes to receiving one or both species. If you are immunocompromised, have respiratory symptoms, or may have been exposed to COVID or flu, it may be best to receive only the host.

We will begin by offering four chalices at each Vigil/Sunday Mass. Please be patient should we run out of the Precious Blood before you come to receive. We will adjust the amount of wine that is consecrated at each Mass as we gain experience with the number of people who seek to receive it.

Please note: One does not need to receive Holy Communion under both species to receive the full grace of the sacrament. The Catechism of the Catholic Church states: "Since Christ is sacramentally present under each of the species, communion under the species of bread alone makes it possible to receive all the fruit of Eucharistic grace." (CCC, No. 1390)




