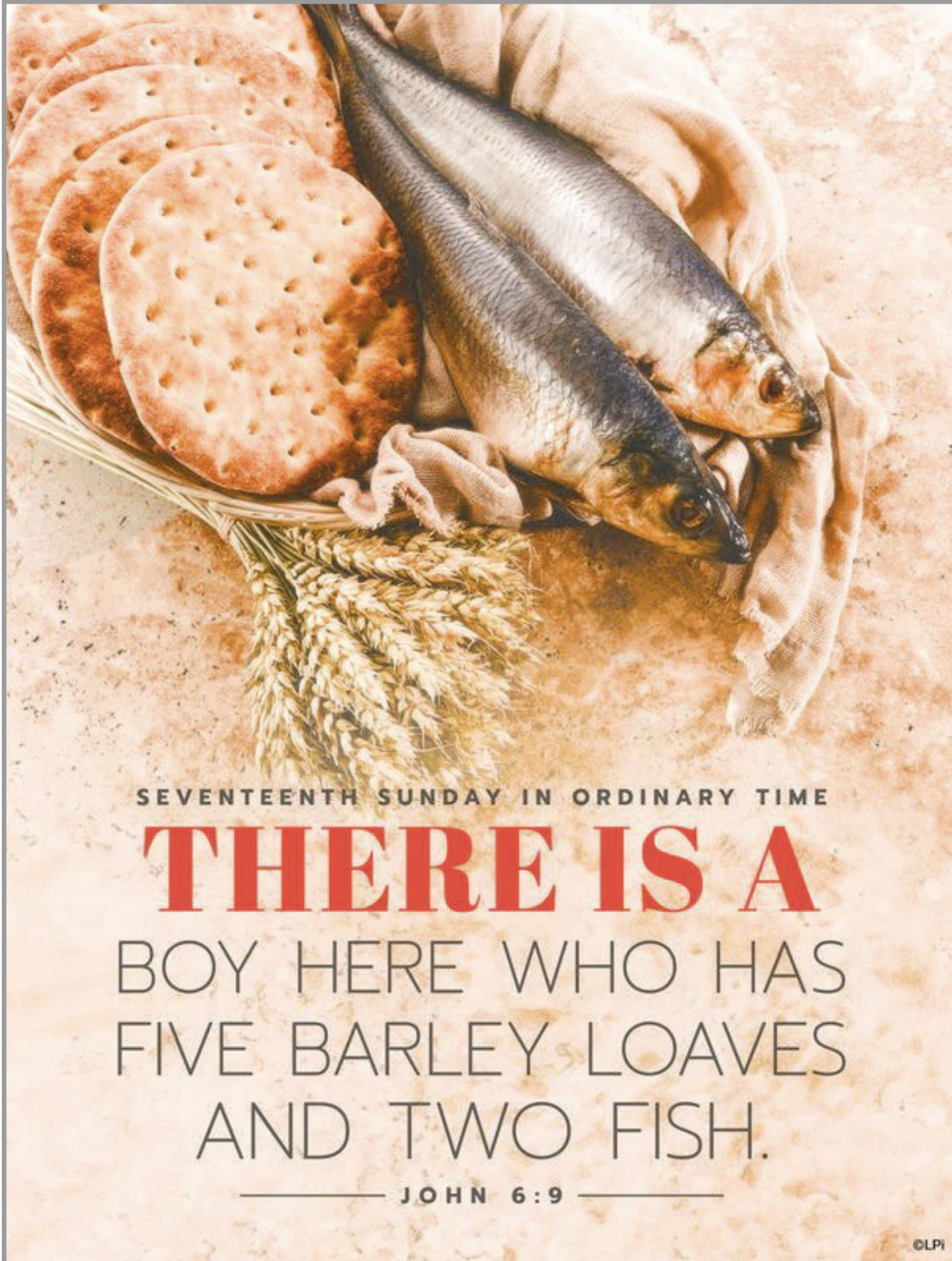

FROM THE DESK OF SR. KAREN ...

What is the message in today's readings? Each story from Jesus' life has a message for us. Let us take time to reflect on what the message may be for us today. The message may be different for each person since God knows where we are on our spiritual journey. Each time we hear or read the Gospels we may be led by a different aspect. Jesus is the image of God for us and, as such, He makes visible for us the generosity of our God which is beyond our imagining.

As I was praying over these readings, I was struck by the compassion and generosity of Jesus for the people. He had been sharing with them all day. I presume many may have brought some food, as they are on the other side of the lake, but others might not have thought about that as they jumped into boats to follow this gifted teacher/preacher/healer. We know one boy had five loaves of bread and two fish and he was willing to share his lunch with anyone. Jesus' compassion may have encouraged others to share, just as the boy had done, and as such, there was enough food for

everyone with 12 baskets of leftovers. As we know from our own potlucks, in the end everyone is invited to take home any leftovers.

So, the lesson I hear from Jesus' teaching this weekend is to share what I have. This lesson is given several times in the Gospels. Jesus takes delight in being with others for a meal. After Jesus' ascension, the early followers shared everything in common to continue this lesson.

As we look at this lesson from our own lives today, has God given us abundant blessings? Are we hoarding or sharing what we have? Our nation has been given so much and we may be hoarding what we have. How can we be a witness for Jesus by sharing with those around us? At times we all are the needy ones, and, in those times, we need to receive with gratitude until the time when we can share with others. We make Compassionate God present in our lives by our living this way.

What a different society we would have if we were able to see how God has given us enough of everything for everyone if we only learned to share.

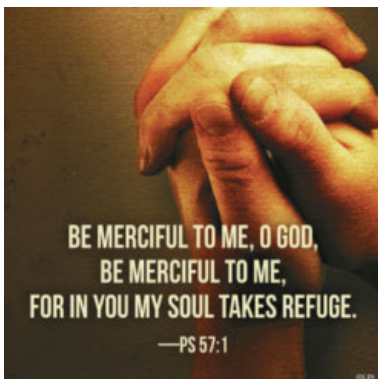

Return to Distribution of the Precious Blood at Holy Communion

Beginning the weekend of August 3-4, 2024, we will once again offer Holy Communion under both species (bread and wine) here at Holy Spirit Parish.

Bishop Michael C. Barber, SJ, released a statement in May 2023 allowing the distribution of the Precious Blood, at the discretion of each pastor. The decision to reintroduce the offering of the chalice post-pandemic here at Holy Spirit has not been made lightly, and we are buoyed by the fact that, according to the CDC, we have "...more tools and resources than ever before to better protect ourselves and our communities."

Each of us should make our own decision when it comes to receiving one or both species. If you are immunocompromised, have respiratory symptoms, or may have been exposed to COVID or flu, it may be best to receive only the host.

We will begin by offering four chalices at each Vigil/Sunday Mass. Please be patient should we run out of the Precious Blood before you come to receive. We will adjust the amount of wine that is consecrated at each Mass as we gain experience with the number of people who seek to receive it.

Please note: One does not need to receive Holy Communion under both species to receive the full grace of the sacrament. The Catechism of the Catholic Church states: "Since Christ is sacramentally present under each of the species, communion under the species of bread alone makes it possible to receive all the fruit of Eucharistic grace." (CCC, No. 1390)

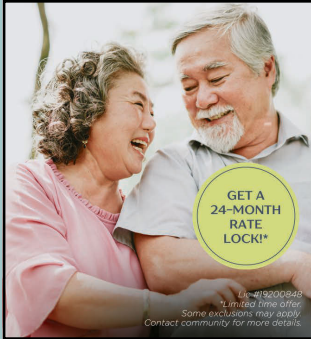
