

FROM THE DESK OF SR. ANNETTE ...

Wisdom, Sophia in Greek, is often referred to as the feminine expression of God. We are told in today's reading from Proverbs that she, God, set her

table, "...dressed her meat, mixed her wine...'To the one who lacks understanding, she says, Come, eat of my food, and drink of the wine I have mixed! Forsake foolishness that you may live; advance in the way of understanding." (Prv 9:2,4-6) Meanwhile, the psalmist explains how we can advance in understanding by tasting and seeing the goodness of God. We do this, by blessing and praising the Lord at all times, by glorifying and extoling God's name, calling out and letting the Lord deliver us from all our fears. (Ps 34:2,3,4) We are all, every one of us, invited to share in this heavenly banquet and grow in wisdom.

St. Paul encourages us to live "as wise" persons (Eph 5:15), "filled with the Spirit" (Eph 5:18) and "giving thanks always and for everything." (Eph 5:20) And in the Gospel, Jesus announces, "I am the living bread that came down from heaven; whoever eats this bread will live forever; and the bread that I will give is my flesh for the life of the world." (John 6:51) Together, Paul and Jesus invite us to participate in the Eucharist ("thanksgiving" in Greek). In this celebration, we bring an offering of thanksgiving for all that God has given us, symbolized in the bread and wine.

The Eucharist, a sacrament, is meant to permeate our lives. We participate in this banquet whenever we attend Mass. Together, we come in thanksgiving for

all that God has given us. We listen and focus on the Scriptures set before us; we sing, praise, bless, glorify, and extol God's name. God accepts our offering of self in the bread and wine, and transforms them into the Body and Blood of Jesus. God then offers the gift of Jesus to us. In the reception of the Eucharist, Holy Communion, we are fed, nourished, and transformed into the Body of Christ. Surely, this is a heavenly banquet!

We do not need to wait until we get to heaven to participate in Wisdom's heavenly banquet. We can practice living in heaven on earth. Each time we participate in Mass, we accept Wisdom's invitation to come and be fed. And as we reflect on the peace, joy, and gratitude for that moment and the moment we are in right now, we have a taste of heaven here on earth. If we choose, we can prolong the experience by taking moments throughout our day to savor our peace, joy and gratitude for we are the Body of Christ. We are in God's presence each moment of every day and we are fed at Wisdom's table.

And so, we pray: Loving God, "who have prepared for those who love you good things which no eye can see, fill our hearts with the warmth of your love, so that, loving you in all things and above all things, we may attain your promises" (Collect) and practice living in heaven each day on earth. Amen.

May you seek the wisdom of God in every aspect of your life!

May your life be transformed in the heavenly banquet that Wisdom offers!

May your days be filled with peace, blessing and praising God in all you do!





2023 PARISH FINANCIAL REPORT



Following is a summary of Holy Spirit's financials for the 2023 fiscal year. As we continue to manage through challenging years, our financials continue to be well managed under the direction of Fr. Ken and the staff. Our commitment is to continue to be transparent with the financials of our parish and we thank you for the ongoing and continued support of Holy Spirit. It is through your generosity we have such a vibrant parish. In the summary of our financials, we included a comparison of 2023 vs 2022 actuals. Holy Spirit has some increasing challenges with slight decreases in revenue and slight increases in expense however continues to be in good financial health. Some key highlights of the 2023 Financials:

Income

- Total Income was \$2.391M; a slight decrease from 2022
- o Plate collections remained consistent with a slight increase year over year
- Gifts and one-time donations were down compared to 2022

Expenses:

- Expenses were and continue to be well managed by the Parish staff as all deal with inflationary pressures with a total of \$2.997M
- Total Expensed increased year over year by approx. \$269K.

Net Operating Income /Loss

 For the 2023 fiscal year, Holy Spirit shows a loss of \$606K of which \$483K is depreciation, a non cash expense

Other Income and Expense

- As we did last year, we included income and expense that are targeted for and managed by Holy Spirit ministries


