FROM THE DESK OF FR BINH...

Have you ever experienced a "good teacher?"

Have you looked for good schools for yourself or your child?

If so, you may relate to the term "good teacher" in today's Gospel.

My mom grew up in a small town in the North of Vietnam. There was no compulsory education in Vietnam, and my grandparents were too poor to send my mom to school. She just took Catechism classes at her parish. When my mom got married and had us, she always looked for good teachers for us. In addition to sending us to school and helping us with homework, my mom made sure we also learned from the good teachers in our community: priests, nuns, monks, and neighbors.

The spirit of wisdom tells us that Jesus is our Good Teacher who can give us treasure in Heaven. If you come to Jesus, the Good Teacher, you should be ready to learn from Him. I guess you know the quote, "God is good all the time, and all the time God is good."

A good teacher, of course, has goodness. God's goodness surpasses our imagination. God is too good to hold anything back for Himself. He gives us everything, and because He loves us, "all things are possible for Him." He accepted the Cross and death to give us salvation. He emptied Himself until the last drop of blood and water. His sacrifice showed us that to love is to give all.

Jesus' goodness challenges the wealthy man in today's Gospel. The wealthy man had a lot of money and didn't want to give his possessions to the poor and follow Jesus. He refused to be as good as Jesus demanded. The possessions we have can prevent us from entering Heaven if we do not use them as a means of following Jesus and doing His will. "No one can serve two masters...You cannot serve God and money."

To follow Jesus, we need to love God and our neighbors unconditionally, as He loves us. May we all learn from Jesus, our Good Teacher, the way to love as He does.


