FROM THE DESK OF ROSALYN...

In last week's Gospel Jesus reminds us that to love God with all the heart and to love one's neighbor as oneself are the

greatest of the commandments. We look at today's Gospel rooted in this love for God and neighbor.

Trust

Jesus, being God incarnate, knew what He was doing. He did not just sit across from the treasury box on a whim, and neither do I think that the widow's appearance was a coincidence. It was a very purposeful action. Widows, especially the poor ones, were the most destitute in Jesus' time.

Today's readings illustrate that God desires faithfulness, not wealth. The things valued in the kingdom of God differ from those that society places value on. The widows' acts in the First and Gospel readings show that they trusted God to take care of them and provide for their needs. Their trust in God is an example of how to live in a way that is faithful to God. God knows our heart and knows when we give little but out of great love. He is able to take that little and do much.

Sacrifice is normal and in fact necessary for the most valuable endeavors. (For example: exercising/giving up certain foods, studying for an exam, or working hard to achieve a certain goal.)

"It's about quality, not quantity."

"Equal sacrifice – not equal gifts."


We have heard these phrases in different contexts. They also apply to our readings today. As we hear in the Gospel, many gave from their abundance what they will never miss, while the widow gave extravagantly what she could not afford—she gave her all. Not equal giving but equal sacrifice!

We place our whole trust in God to provide all the graces we need and give sacrificially for the needs, accompaniment, and wellbeing of our neighbors. We are to give willingly of ourselves to God and in service of our fellow men. God can work wonders even with the smallest gifts we have to share; recall the five loaves of bread and two fish (Matthew 14:13–21).

When we are considering generously giving of our time, treasure, and talents, and doubt whether we will have enough for ourselves, let us always keep in our hearts the words from scripture: "Give and gifts will be given to you; a good measure, packed together, shaken down, and overflowing, will be poured into your lap." (Luke 6:38)

Blessed are the poor in spirit, for theirs is the kingdom of God."


