

FROM THE DESK OF DN TIM...

In England, between 1455 and 1487, there was a series of civil wars known as the War of the Roses. The battle was for the right to the King's throne; with

the throne came great power and glory. Everyone involved was fighting for their own interest and agenda. Power can do this, yet today, we celebrate a day of true power in the Church – the Solemnity of Christ the King.

In Christ, the King of Kings was born into humanity to elevate humanity. In doing so, Jesus introduced us to His throne, a throne in which would come great power and glory, a throne which would be the vehicle to save His people. Jesus' throne was the Cross, and Christ shares the glory of His throne not for His own sake, but out of pure love for the people of God.

Christ came as a King and, as a King, He conquered yet needed no army. Christ's enemy

was sin and, as a true King, He took on the battle for His people Himself. In going to the Cross, Christ took on our sin and paid our debt. There is no earthly King who would take on all of this for nothing in return but a painful death on a Cross.

In our broken world, each of us, Christian or not, will face the brutality of our sin and the cost is the Cross. Christ tells us Christians to take up our cross, because He knows our suffering is not the end of the story. Our Gospel today takes place on Good Friday; can you imagine the glory of Christ if His story ends on Good Friday? It is by the Cross on Good Friday our King pours out His blood for our salvation. It is Good Friday that ushers in Easter Sunday. So, when you face the suffering of the Cross, please remember our story ends in Resurrection.

So today, let's celebrate for our King Jesus Christ has conquered sin and death and we share the glory through His grace.

Happy Solemnity!


Immediately after the 5:00 pm Mass, stay for a live Christmas play, performed by our Faith Formation children.




