

FROM THE DESK OF FR BINH...

How do you prepare for Christmas? Hopefully, everything is almost ready.

Today is the Fourth Sunday of Advent, and Christmas will come in two days. We are very close to the joy of Christmas. Have you seen that yet?

The joy of Christmas should be external and internal. All decorations and presents should be considered external joy. Baby Jesus' presence in our hearts is the internal joy. We need to have a Christmas with Christ.

Jesus will come to you if you have prepared well. Hopefully, the Advent pilgrimage into the heart of Scripture in Fr. Mark Toups' book will help you to rejoice in Christmas properly.


Think of the message "the Kingdom of God is at hand" as a declaration that Jesus is right around the corner. He is very close to us. We need to make space for Jesus at Christmas and welcome Him. This is a transformation of spiritual life.

If we want to improve ourselves, let Him reconcile us and forgive our sins in the Sacrament of Reconciliation. Let Him feed us with His Body and Blood. Let Him make us His disciples by His Spirit and words. Let Him stay with us and show Himself to us. Let Him be visible in our lives. That is a divine joy: Jesus born in us.

Christmas is meant to be a holiday spent with Christ. If we celebrate with Christ in our hearts, then that is an excellent reason to rejoice. Mary shared her joy with her cousin Elizabeth and Elizabeth's son John, and she became the first disciple to proclaim the Good News to others. The Good News is Jesus in Mary's womb.

Mary recognized she had the Shepherd of Israel, whom the prophets prophesied. She also knew that she was blessed to be the Mother of God. Jesus was born in her, and this joy should be shared, so she did.

In today's Gospel, Mary, a pregnant woman, traveled a long way to bring the greatness of God to her cousin Elizabeth and their family. We should imitate Mary and bring Jesus "to the ends of the earth." In that way, the joy of Christmas will be multiplied.


